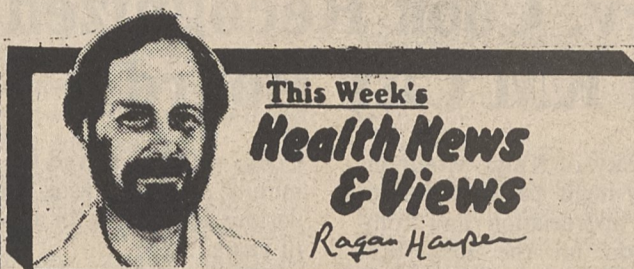
Cancer Society Sets 'I Can Cope' Program

To a degree, your lifestyle determines your longevity and quality of life. I hope it already includes shopping our pharmacy!



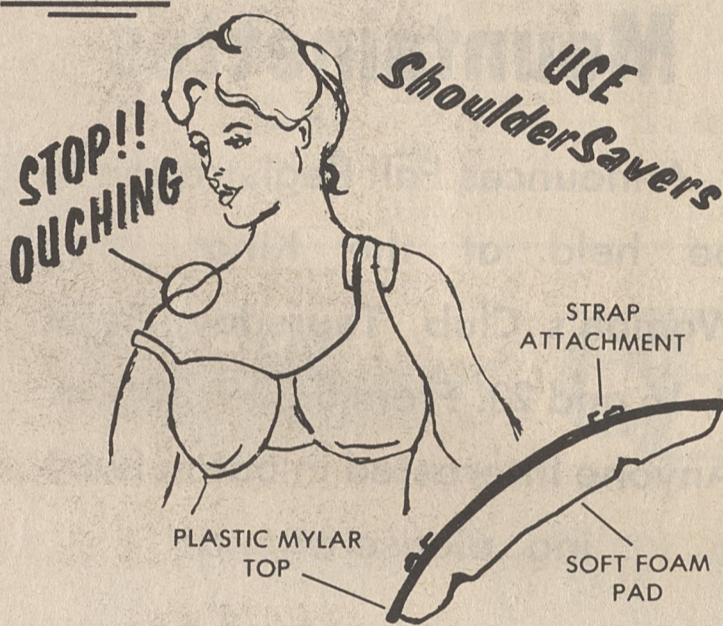

Chastening Of The Lord

What does God mean in HEB 12:5, "...despise not thou the chastening of the Lord...". How does He chasten us? The same word that is translated "chasten" is also translated in the King James Version as "nurture" in Ephesians 6:4 and as "instruction" in 2 TIMOTHY 3:16.

"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction (chastening) in righteousness." (2 TIMOTHY 3:16).

In JOHN 4:24, we read that God is a Spirit. We have had fathers of flesh who corrected us in a fleshly manner and we also have a spiritual Father who corrects us in a spiritual manner (HEB 12:9). PROVERBS 1:23, 29-33 tells us that His words are our reproof, or correction. The calamity that follows those who do not listen is the eating of the fruit of their way. But, those who listen to the Lord, to His chastening word, live safely and quiet from fear of evil. We see that the chastening is instruction and guidance from the word and Spirit of God.

"It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak to you, they are spirit, and they are life." (JOHN 6:63).
