"No. No," said the actor. "Did you see me in pictures?"

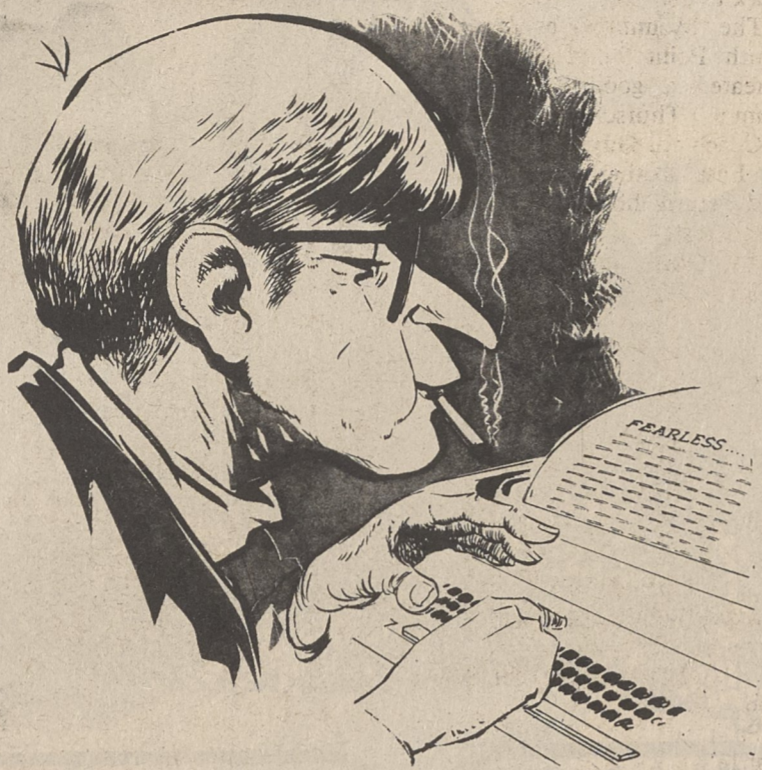
"Yes. And take my advice. Buy that butcher shop."
