### Bobby Huskey Retires From Air National Guard

CHARLOTTE—A Hendersonville pilot was honored by the N.C. Air National Guard upon his retirement August 7 in a ceremony in Charlotte.

Lt. Col. Bobby P. Huskey, Chief of Operation Plans, 145th Tactical Air Group, received the Air Force and N.C. National Guard Commendation Medals for 21 years of outstanding service as a pilot with the Air Guard.

With six years of active duty prior to joining the Guard in 1962, Huskey accumulated more than 5,000 hours of flying time during his career, many of which were on the C-130B Hercules aircraft.

Presently a 17-year veteran pilot with Pan American World Airways, Huskey will continue his civilian piloting out of JFK International Airport in Jamaica, New York.

Huskey began his military career in the ROTC program at N.C. State University where he graduated with an engineering degree in 1957.

He completed high school at Bethware High School in Kings Mountain, where his parents, Mr. and Mrs. W.B. Huskey, still reside.

Huskey is married to the former Laura L. Morris of Kings Mountain. They have four children—Robert, Michael, Eric and Carol.

### Completes Training

The basic camp is designed to give junior college graduates and college sophomores who have not taken ROTC courses the chance to enter the program. The camp also qualifies high school graduates for the ROTC

During the encampment, cadets received training in basic rifle marksmanship, military drill and ceremonies, communications and individual and small unit tactics.

### Local Firm Gets Contract

A small business in Gastonia will provide \$31,664 worth of gears for use by the U.S. military services. The Defense Construction Supply Center (DCSC) of Columbus, Ohio, announced the award of the new contract today to the Ferguson Gear, of 4032 Bessemer City Rd., 28052.

With an inventory of over 350,000 items, the Center last year bought over \$540 million worth of items that ranged from lumber and wood products to plumbing accessories such as pipe, pumps, valves and fittings. Repair parts are purchased for vehicles as simple as commercial trucks and sedans as complex as military aircraft, ships and submarines. DCSC also buys such major end items as tractors, cranes, road machinery, forklifts and mechanized materials handling equipment. DCSC is a field installation of the Defense Logistics Agency, Washington, D.C.



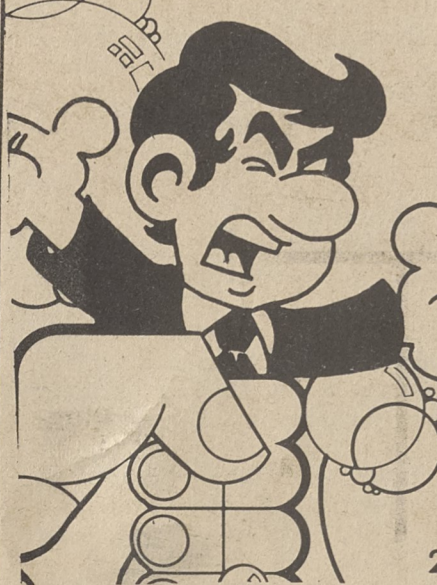
