There were 1,200 delegates representing 225,000 P.E.O. members in the United States and Canada.

The P.E.O. Sisterhood is a philanthropic organization whose interests are directed to education for women. Its international projects include the P.E.O. Educations Fund, Cottey Junior College for Women, International Peace Scholarship Fund, and the Program for Continuing Education.

The Educational Fund was created to assist qualified women in attaining educational goals. Since its inception in 1907, an aggregate in excess of \$8,000,000 has been used by more than 22,500 students.

Cottey College, located in Nevada, Missouri, is a liberal arts junior college for women. Founded in 1884, it has been owned and supported by P.E.O. since 1927. Cottey is fully accredited and prepares its 350 students for secondary colleges.
