

Premiere Dedicated To Frances

The world premiere of "Set for Life", a comedy written by Howard Richardson and the late Frances Goforth of Kings Mountain, was dedicated to the memory of Miss Goforth Thursday at the Kingsport, Tn., Civic Auditorium.

The play was produced by the Kingsport Players and City of Kingsport Recreation Department.

Representing Miss Goforth at the play were her sister, Mrs. Millie Goforth Myers; her sister-in-law, Mrs. Eugene (Faye) Goforth; and Mrs. Iva L. Beam, all of Kings Mountain; her niece, Mrs. Jeannie Goforth Burns of Gastonia; and Mrs. Verda Elliott of Robbinsville, N.C.

Miss Goforth was a graduate of Kings Mountain High School and the University of North Carolina. She taught school for two years in Bessemer City before moving to New York, where she and Richardson wrote a number of Broadway plays, including "Dark of the Moon." She moved back to Kings Mountain about six months before she died with cancer.

"Set for Life" takes place in Bessemer City a couple of years after World War II. The story is centered around Sadie Childers, who is a the matriarch of a boarding house that is home for her eccentric, Scripture-quoting brother, C.R., another family member, Inez, and a light-brained character named Crystal.

Another member of the family, Maude Ivy, has been away at a beauty school in Virginia and is returning home with her new husband, Ernie, who is a sailor and a Yankee.

Sadie, a true Southerner, dislikes Ernie from the outset and dislikes him even more when Maude brings him home. Sadie tries to have the marriage annulled.
