hire at least 20 new employees by the end of next year. The company now employs 30 people.

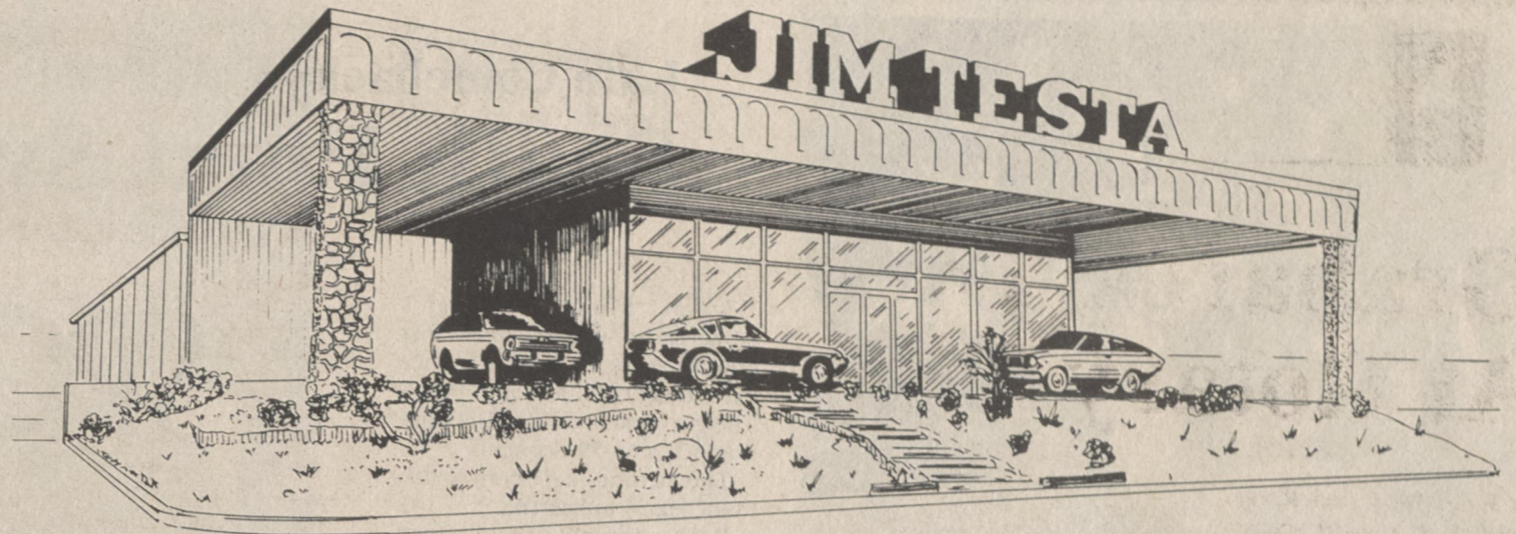
"Business has increased dramatically and we are now negotiating purchase of three additional lines of vehicles, as we have expanded to become one of the largest dealers in the area. Where new vehicles are concerned we have increased business since moving from downtown 500 percent," said Testa.

Testa said that other changes will include the addition of a se-

cond shift in the Service department for the convenience of working people.

Tests said that target date for completion of construction is Feb. 1 and that local contractors will be utilized. American Builders of Roebuck, S.C. will construct the new metal frame building with masonry front for the new showroom.

north and adjacent to Phifer Hardware.

The city has 18 parcels or approximately four acres of land in the downtown and Cansler Urban Renewal Area it is offering to Kings Mountain buyers as an incentive to build in Kings Mountain.

Director White calls the program an "aggressive approach to revitalizing and building up downtown Kings Mountain. He said the three parcels of land sold recently represent a total investment of \$350,000 and offers the buyers a permanent tax base, more revenue for the city and more jobs in the community. "We're just real excited about the response we're getting," he added.
