Payne Appointed Postmaster

Richard E. Payne is appointed the new postmaster at Bessemer City, effective Saturday, April 14, Sectional Center Manager/Postmaster Walter E. Crowe of Charlotte announced today.

Payne, 53, a native of Bessemer City, has served as Superintendent, Postal Operations, in the Bessemer City Post Office for the past twelve years.

Postmaster selections are made on the basis of merit from a list of qualified candidates submitted to the Sectional Center Manager by a Review Committee. The Review Committee, composed of a district director from the same district, a sectional center director or postmaster from the same sectional center and a sectional center manager or postmaster from a different district, reviews the applicants for the position and recommends to the sectional center manager those candidates who best meet the position requirements. The sectional center manager then selects and recommends to the Postmaster General the best suited person for appointment to the vacancy. Mr. Payne and his wife, Evelene, have one son, Rick, age 22.

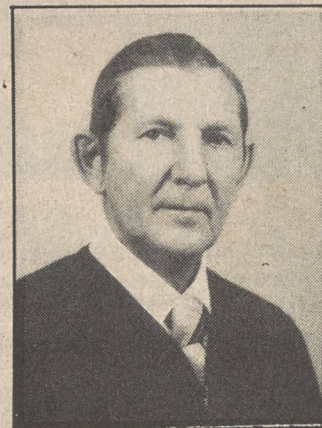

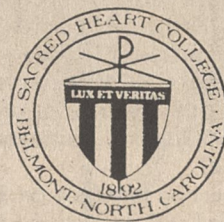
