

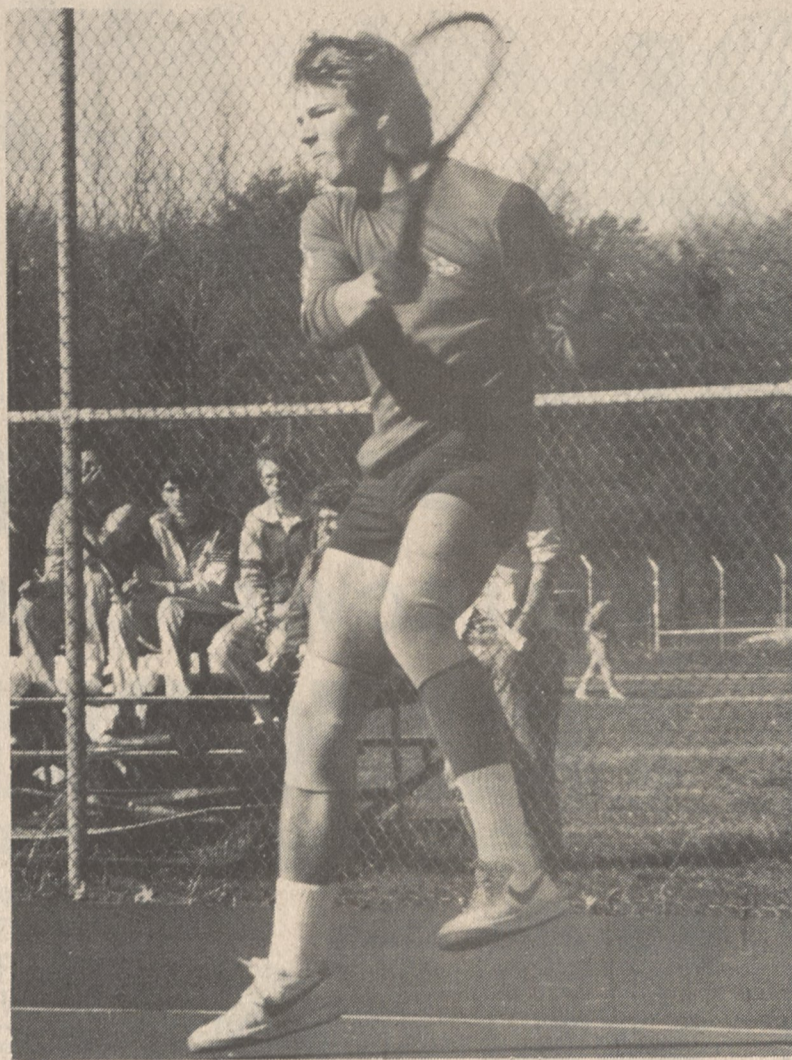
Netters Defeat Chargers

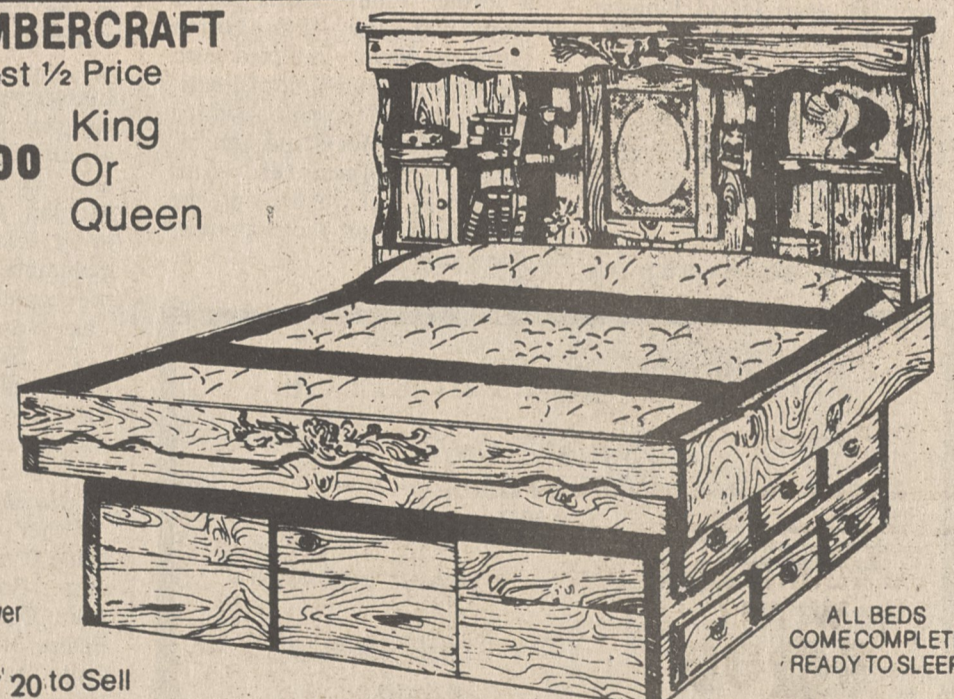
