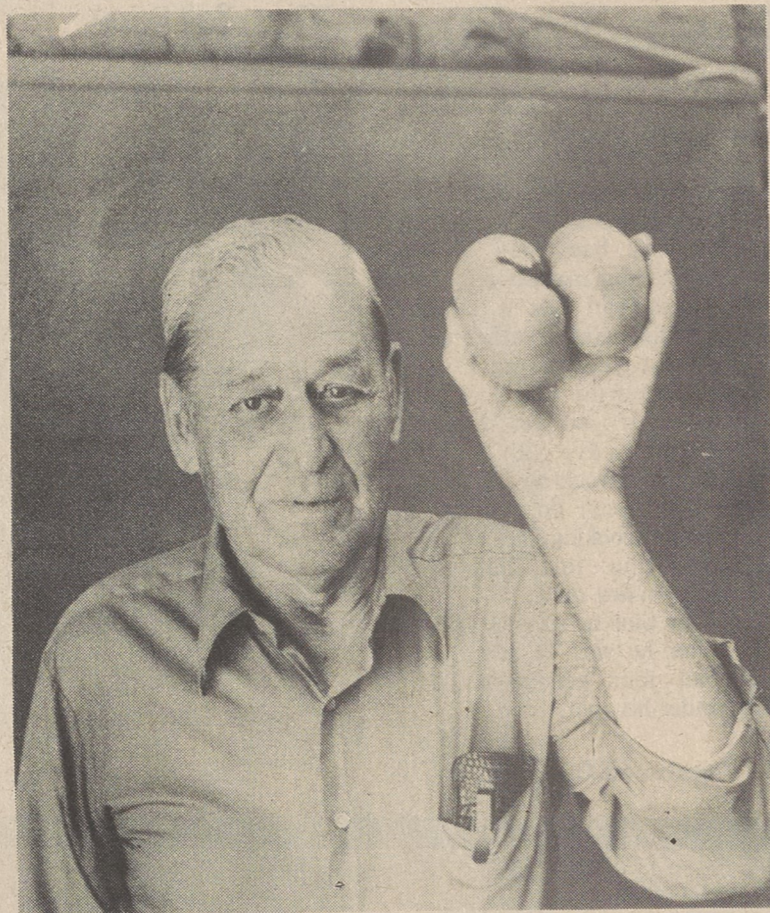

In addition, the Squad transported 42 patients to Kings Mountain Hospital, one patient to Kings Mountain Convalescent Center, seven patients to Cleveland Memorial Hospital at Shelby, five patients to Gaston Memorial Hospital in Gastonia; eight patients to Charlotte Memorial Hospital, one patient to Shelby Convalescent Center; five patients to out-of-town doctor's offices, two patients in town doctor's offices.

He liked to talk about his

"We'd stay on the road three days. The very first day I peddled in Bessemer City, I spent the night with N.C. Dobbins on West Washington Avenue. The next night we camped under a clump of trees between Bessemer City and Gastonia."

In the 1940's he swapped his wagon for the Model A roadster he was still driving toward his half-century years of peddling. He used its cooter shell to carry his produce. He placed his milk, buttermilk, eggs and butter beside him on the eat. Bags of peanuts were worked into the area between the fenders and car.

His antique car that he drove 30 miles an hour attracted attention parked or traveling. When fellow travelers found out who was holding up the traffic speed, it was always alright when they found out it was Johnny Wright.
