## **Grover To Condemn Land For Sewer System**

Although commissioners noted their action would be an unpopular step for them as city council members with the voters, they agreed that a sewer system for the town would be worth any unpopularity with voters at the next city election.

Appraiser Ralph Gilbert of Lawndale will be in Grover this weekend to begin the appraisal of all properties the sewer lines will cross and establish compensation for any damages, such as felling trees, etc. After the appraisal of the 60 plus properties, the property owners will be notified by letter from Attorney Neisler and they will have the option of concurring with the town or filing suits. After 30 days the town will file suit against those property owners who do not agree to right-of-

Bid letting for the project is expected to get underway in

"It's either to go this route or to postpone the start of the sewer project which could mean

that federal funds would be cut off", said Neisler, who said that some 10-12 property owners had already voluntarily signed rightof-way papers but at least 50 have not and are "wary and we have met resistance from many", Neisler said. "Making any change in the proposed sewer line," said Neisler, "might seriously hamper the entire project and cause a cutoff of funds". After Gilbert's appraisal of the properties, citizens are invited to see Grover officials to avoid court action, said Neisler.

The installation of a sewer system in Grover is expected to increase the value of properties, said board members who said they appreciated those few property owners who had already signed right-of-way acquisition papers, noting that these property owners would also be asked to allow Ralph Gilbert to appraise their properties in "fairness to all property owners". The board indicated it would pay up to two cents a square foot for right-ofway and would take whatever necessary to see the beginning and completion of a sewer project for the town of Grover.


