and classrooms. The grant, \$29,900 from the state, will be matched by \$4,987.50 in cash and \$4,987.50 in kind by the city who will provide work crews for the renovation. Renovation is scheduled to begin soon and is expected to be completed by summer.

The board accepted flower bulbs from the Open Gate Garden Club to beautify Kings Mountain Parking Plaza and approved resolution to seek state maintenance of the Boy Scout Camp Road by authorizing a letter to the N.C. Department of Transportation requesting that Boy Scout Camp Road be added to the state system for maintenance but stating assurances that responsibility for impoundment of Davidson Lake, any damage that may result from and maintenance of the dam, or appurtenances, shall remain with the City of Kings Mountain.

The board amended municipal trust agreements and approved petitions for street improvements, curb and gutter, from Lee Street to Southwood Street and from Lee Street to Fulton Street to end of street.
