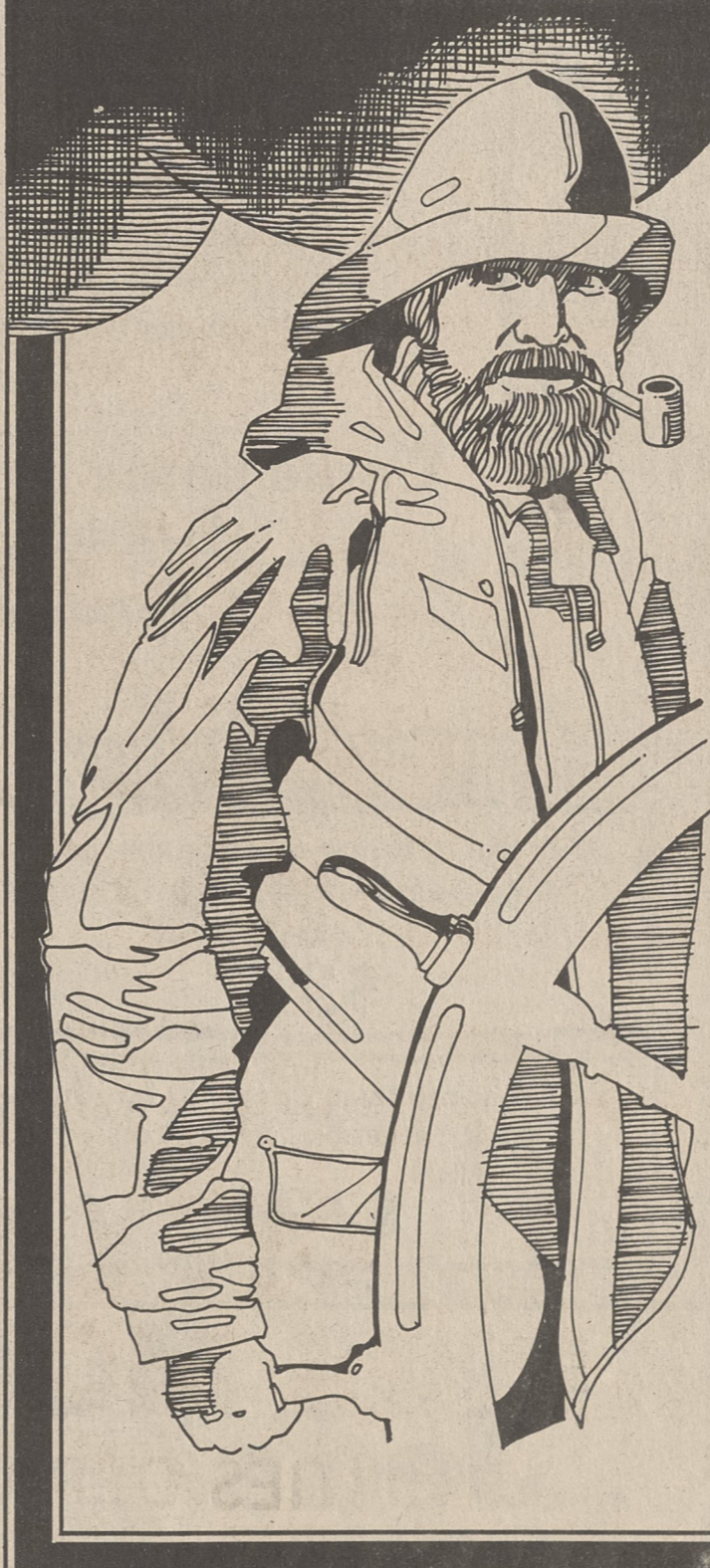
Blood test detects coronary risks
