Champion of WXIK and Bob Davis of WOHS will be "jailed" in a mock jail to be set up behind center stage in Cleveland Mall for 30 hours and will conduct the tele-thon from the jail cell, asking radio listeners to come to the Mall and bring their checks and donations or to make pledges over the air and mail checks and donations to Bullet Busters Fund, P.O. Box 1590, Shelby, N.C. 28150.

The Bullet Busters Fund hopes to raise at least \$8500 to purchase bullet proof vests for the 35 members of the Cleveland County Sheriff's Department, including reserve officers. Chick Filet, one of the sponsors for the telethon, will give a \$2.50 donation for each \$5.00 purchase of food during the 30 hour operation and will have Chick Filet open the entire time. The Mall will also be open for 30 hours during the promotion and citizens will be invited to visit the headquarters for the benefit and talk to the radio personalities in their "jail cells."


