



The proposed Standard Course of Study specifies sub-jects and skills to be taught at each grade level in the public schools and is an overview of the basic curriculum which should be made available to every child in the public schools of North Carolina. It includes the areas of arts education, communication skills, healthful living, library/media skills, copy of the child's legal birth mathematics, science, second languages, social studies, student services, and

Also, a public hearing on the revised "North Carolina Standard Course of Study" is scheduled for March 29 in Raleigh. The hearing, an-nounced by the State Board of Education, will be held at 9 a.m. in the State Board Meeting Room on the third floor of the Education Building on Salisbury Street.



K-Screening Scheduled

Children who enter kindergarten this fall will be involved in a screening program at their respective schools in May. To be eligible the child must be five years old on or before October 15, 1985.

The screening will be conducted by a team of school personnel including teachers, psychologists, speech therapists, the school nurse, the social worker, and the principal at each school. Three sessions are planned for each day with fifteen children screened at each session. Screening will begin at 8:30 a.m., the second ses-sion will be at 10:30 a.m., and the last at 1:30 p.m. Parents should contact the


school in their district prior to April 10, 1985 to secure necessary forms and make an appointment for the screening. Appointments are made on a first-come-firstserve basis. If the parent does not know which school his child will attend, he may call the District School Office, 739-4589 and get the information.


Parents are expected to attend the pre-school screening with their child in order to participate in the orientation. This, also, includes parents of children presently enrolled ir. Headstart.

In addition to the completed registration forms, which can be secured from certificate (NOT the hospital record), his/her "shot" record, and a copy of the physical examination by the family doctor or Health Department.
