In the Fourth-Fifth Grade Division Becky Senter danced to "Footloose" and Tammy Tessener, Michael Phillips, Tasha Parker, Je

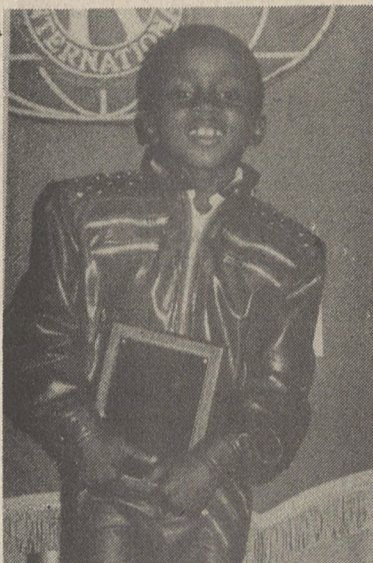

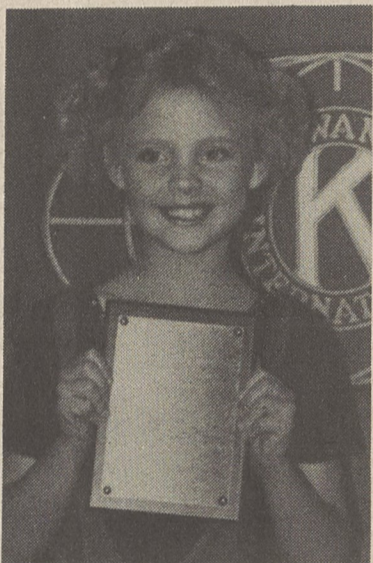

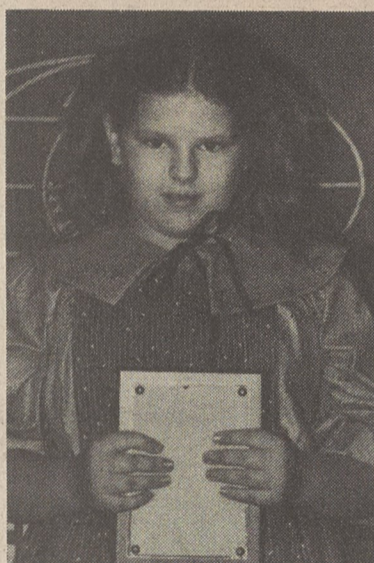
