Scouts Honor Local People

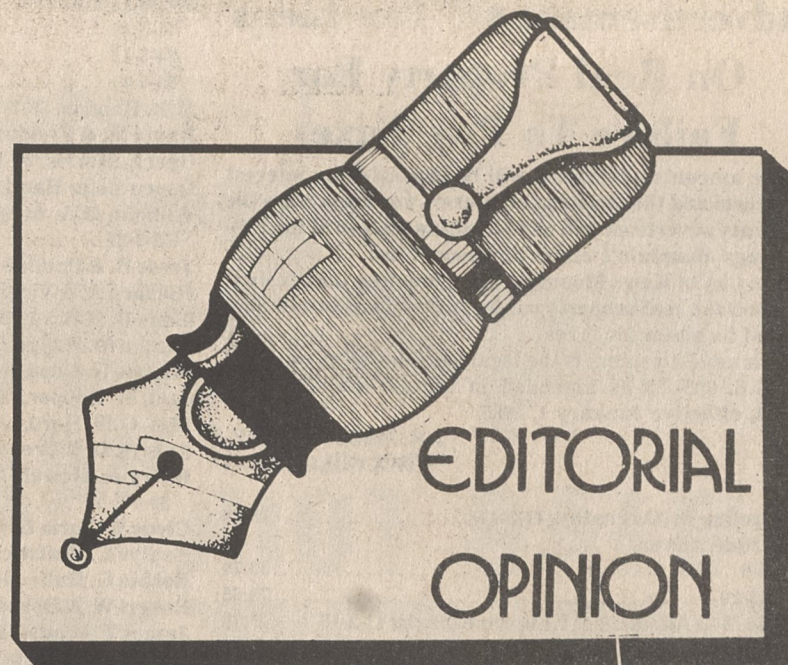

LOOKING BACK

(From the Thursday, May 9, 1957 edition of The Kings Mountain Herald)

Kings Mountain voters will determine next Tuesday whether they want sodium fluoride as an addition to the city water supply. Kings Mountain citizens will go to the polls next Tuesday to elect a city administration and to endorse the candidates of two school board trustees. For Mayor, three candidates are vying. Mayor Glee A. Bridges, running for a third term "on the record", is opposed by Former Mayor Garland E. Still and J. Lee Roberts. In Ward 5, Rev. S.T. Cooke seeks to unseat the incumbent W.G. Grantham, asking a third two year term, as does R. Coleman Stroupe. Other candidates are Sam Collins, incumbent, and Ross Alexander in Ward 1; J.C. Clary, Dewitte Cornwell, Boyce Gault and Tillman Pearson in Ward 2; T.J. Ellison, incumbent, and Luther Bennett in Ward 3; and Paul Ledford, incumbent, Ben Bridges and Charles W. Ford in Ward 4. The two candidates for the two school trustee seats are Fred W. Plonk and Dr. P.G. Padgett.

Delbert Dixon was installed Tuesday night as president of the Kings Mountain Jaycees.
