

Tom Gilbert Named Director Of Marketing

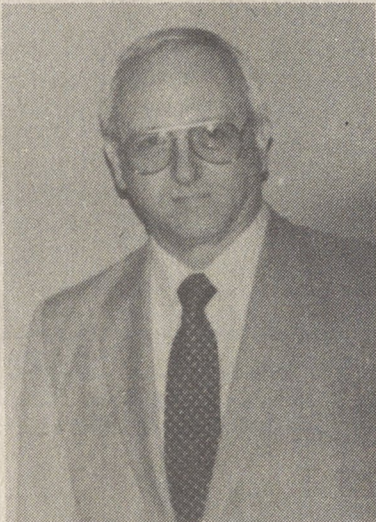
Tom Gilbert has joined Associated Electro-Medical Services of Stallings, N.C. as Director of Marketing.

The Kings Mountain man was previously a sales representative for several years with American Scientific Products, Evanston, Ill. A.E.S. Inc. began in 1973 as

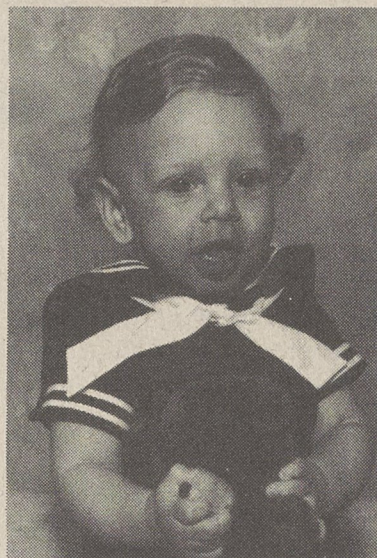
