(3) At age 50 or 51, a special examination where the physician inspects the rectum and lower colon with a lighted tube, called sigmoidoscope, which is used in the examina-tion, is much less uncomfortable than the old, rigid tube.

The Cancer Society recom-mends that anyone with a family history of the cancer should begin this screening regimen early, at the age of 30. About 93% of colon and rectum cancer occurs in people older than 50, and occurs in men and women at about the same rate per the Cancer Society.
