"Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on Him, If ye continue in My word, then are ye My disciples indeed;

"And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (John 8:31-32)

Charles H. Spurgeon gives a good illustration of the way we often are, and should not be, in a devotional entitled *Abiding With Christ*. He said, "We are too much like the bird we read of in the old Saxon story. When the first missionary was preaching in the royal hall, he told of the peace which the gospel brings to sinners, and the rest which souls find in Jesus. After his sermon, and an ancient chieftain spake his mind, and compared himself and his countrymen in their unrest to the bird which just then attracted by the light, flew into the bright hall through the open window, flitted through the warmth and light, and passed out again into the darkness and the cold by a window on the other side of the banquet hall; the simile might well apply to our transient fellowship; we have brief communings, and then away we pass into worldliness and indifference. Oh, would it not be blessed if we could abide with Jesus for ever, building our rest in His palace!"

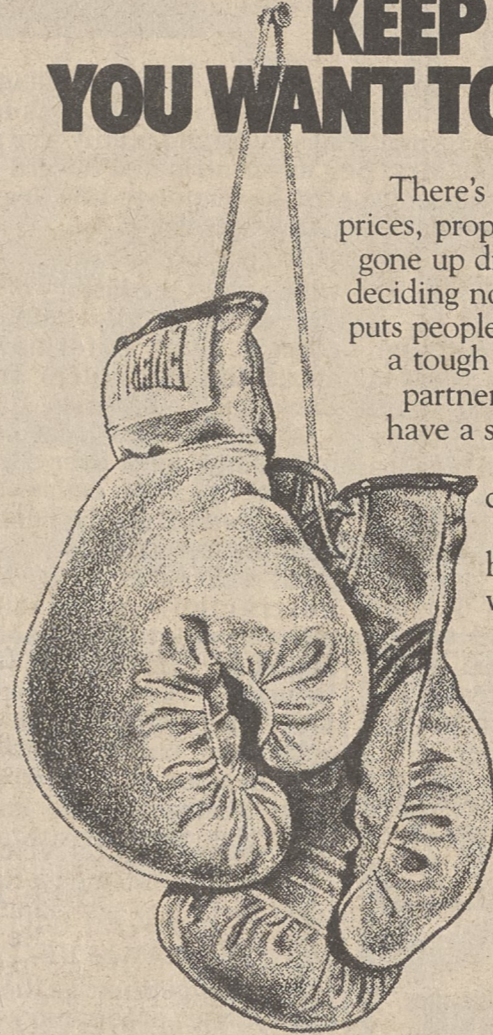
"How heavenly our life if

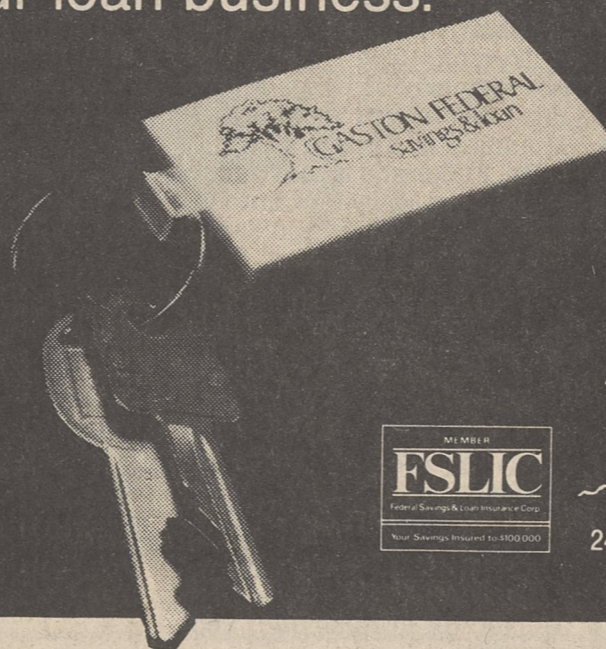
