In a related matter, the town authorized Neisler to make an offer to a property owner for street right of way on Pine Street. Acquiring that right of way is necessary to have an entrance to a pump station.

In other action Monday, the board approved a revision in the proposed recreation park plan to include a picnic shelter and multi-purpose building at difference loca-

tions in the park.

Mayor Bill McCarter suggested moving the picnic shelter, which will be a 24 by 30 feet structure, to the wooded area of the park. That move, he said, would remove the shelter which is expected to be used largely by a senior citizens group, away from the ballfields which will be used

mainly by younger people.

The multi-purpose building, which will include two restrooms, concession stand and storage room, will be located near the two ballfields. The town also plans a tennis court at the

Ruth Gamble, member of El Bethel Church of Kings Mountain, remembers Golden as a "young man of much compassion and well liked in the church and com-munity." Golden, according to his Kings Mountain friends, was always doing things for the sick and shut-in and the elderly. "He was very kind and everyone in our church liked him and hated to see him move on. Jake wanted to go where there was a higher need", said Mrs. Gamble.

Golden's parents, Rev. and Mrs. J.B. Golden, Sr., of Asheville's Central United Methodist Church, have received a flood of calls from area people and said they deeply appreciated their con-cern for their son, who they said had their support. Golden had taken a leave of absence for one year to serve in Nicaragua with the Witness for Peace organization whose work is what the name implies. He and the others live and work and play with the people, mostly peasants, in the frontier villages where there is much suffering, working with farmers in the fields, ministering to children. Some of his friends and family recently sent Golden color books and crayons and other essentials for a large group of children in that area.

Witness for Peace has brought in the past two years more than 1,500 people from the U.S. to hold vigils and prayer sessions in tense areas of Nicaragua and these participants fund their own

trips. The Witness for Peace activists are in Nicaragua to protest the Reagan administration's expressed support for the contras, and to campaign for peace between the United States and Nicaragua.

Friends of Golden say he knew the risks when he signed up with Witness for Peace but he wanted to go.


