

G-W Enrollment Up For Fall Programs

Figures for the 1985 fall semester at Gardner-Webb College show that 1816 students are enrolled.

Significant growth is reflected in five programs including the graduate, Greater Opportunities for Adult Learners (GOAL), fine arts, nursing and communications.

The graduate program has increased from 122 students in the fall of 1984 to 187 this fall. The figures reflect the Boiling Springs campus as well as the Statesville, Marion and Rockingham campuses.

"We've been in Statesville for two years and have started the second cycle there," said Dr. Gil Blackburn, director of graduate studies. "We've been able to recruit new students continually."

We use Gardner-Webb faculty almost exclusively and have the same programs off campus and on campus."

The GOAL program encompasses 15 satellite campuses in North and South Carolina.

"We have a head count of 521 and the highest average per course enrollment in the history of the program," said Dr. Larry Sale, assistant academic vice president for special studies.

The department of fine arts has 17 new music majors in their program. According to Dr. George Cribb, chairman of the department of fine arts, this number of students is the best in about five years.

"This is the first year we have not had to offer developmental theory," said Dr. Cribb. "I think that speaks well of the quality of students as well as the number."

The bachelor of science in nursing (BSN) program at the Boiling Springs campus reports that 15 students are starting the program this fall. According to Cindy Miller, assistant professor of nursing, six students began

the program in the fall of 1984.

The communications degree program, in its second year, has also shown growth. Twenty-five students began the program last fall and an additional 21 students have expressed an interest in the degree this fall.

"We're very pleased with the interest in this program," said Dr. Bill Stowe, director of the communications program. "Twenty plus new students exceed our expectations for this year."

Paige would like to thank her sponsors in Kings Mountain for sponsoring her in the pageant.

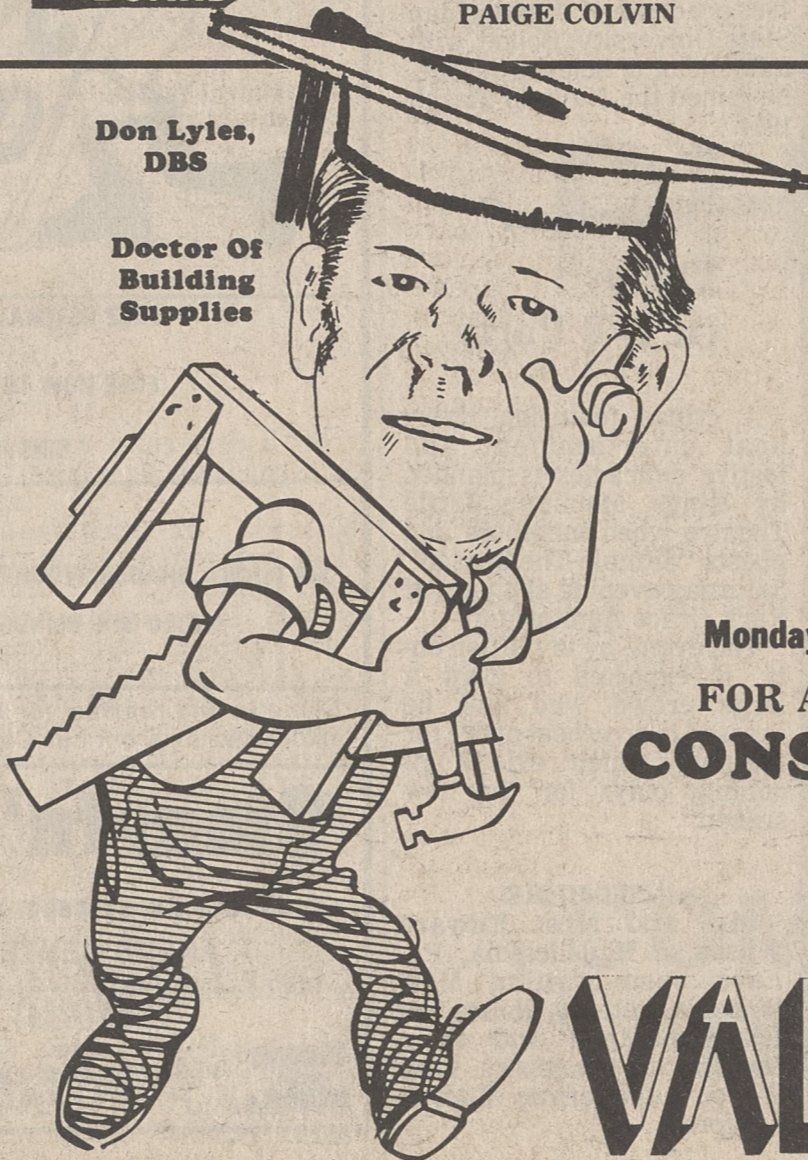

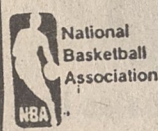
