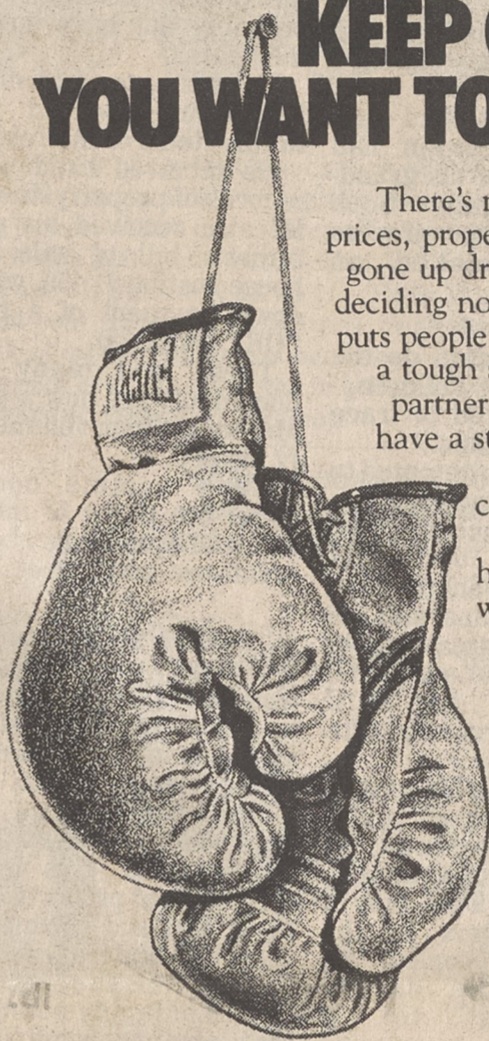
**Christmas EMPORIUM**

A report is to be filed with the 1987 General Assembly.

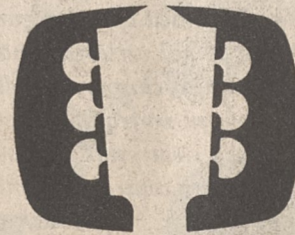
