To House Committee

Representative Edith L. Lutz of Rutherford County has been appointed by House Speaker Liston B. Ramsey to a special committee to study the procedures for incorporating cities and towns in North Carolina.

The study will be conducted under authority of the Legislative Research Commission. It will cover "the process of municipal incorporation, including the existence of paper cities and inactive cities, the effect of incorporations on road construction procedures, allocation of funds, county governments and other nearby municipalities.

Mrs. Lutz, a resident of Lawndale, is chairman of the House Local Government II Committee. She represents the 48th House District made up of Cleveland, Polk and Rutherford Counties.

Representative Charles D. Owens of Rutherford County has been appointed by House Speaker Liston B. Ramsey to a special committee to study the premium tax rate for insurance companies in North Carolina.

The study will be conducted under authority of the Legislative Research Commission. It grew out of legislation introduced in the 1985 General Assembly seeking to provide for a uniform premium tax structure for all companies doing business in North Carolina.
