

## Andy Williams Completes Basic

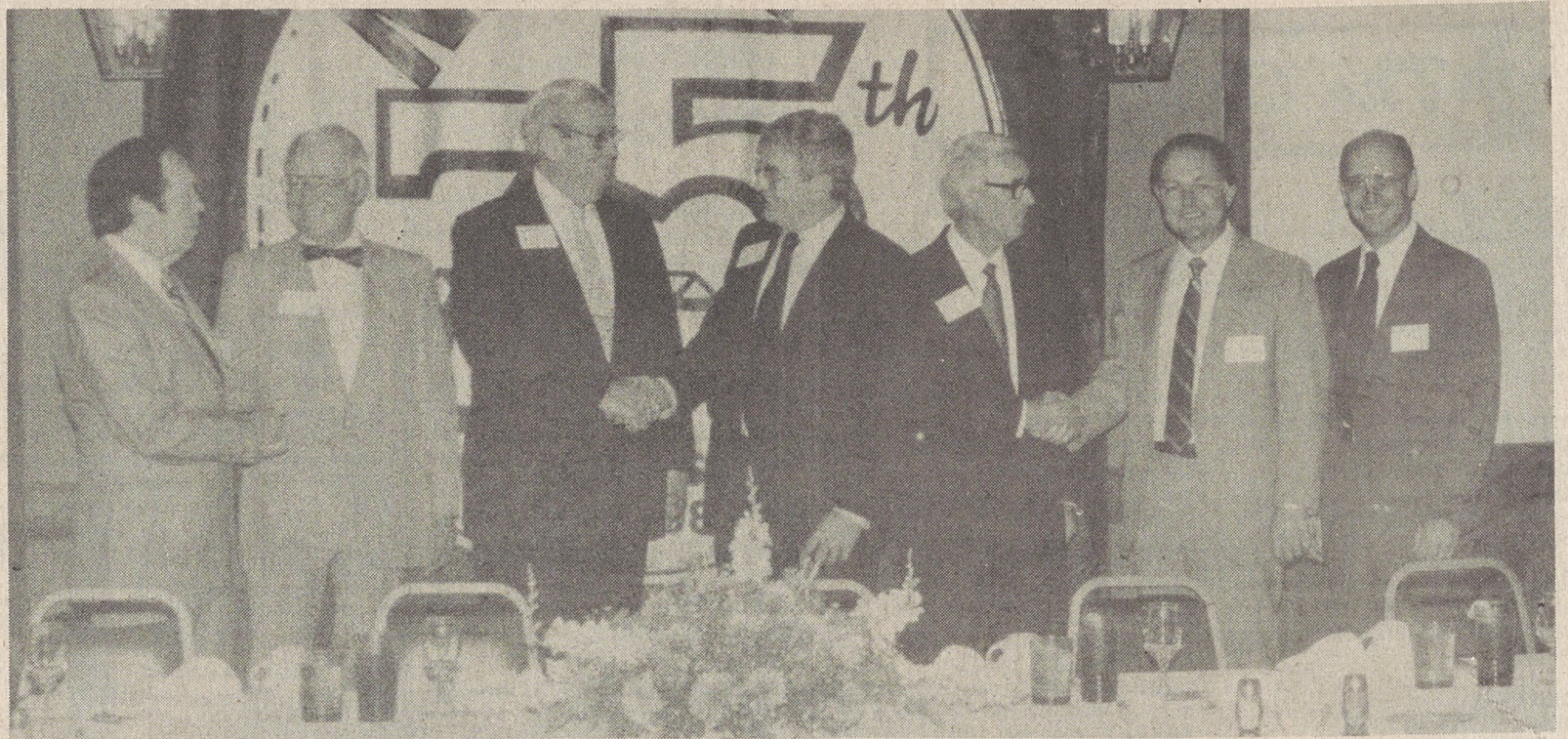

in drill and ceremonies, weapons, map reading, tactics, military courtesy, military justice, first aid, and Army history and tradition.

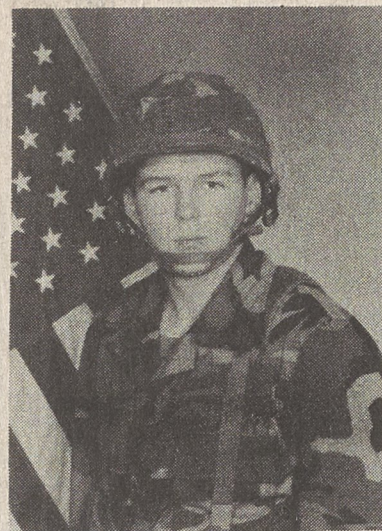
She is a 1983 graduate of Kings Mountain Senior High School.
