## KM Firemen Conduct Inspection At KM Hospital

Fire safety at Kings Mountain Hospital means keeping people safe while providing quality health care.

Fire safety in health care facilities presents unique problems because of flammable substances such as liquid or gaseous chemicals and because of patients who may be incapacitated or may require special protection and help.

This is why it is important that every member of the health care team knows how to prevent fires, sound the alarm, evacuate patients, and fight fires effectively. Employees participate in routine monthly fire drills so they will be prepared in case of fire. In-services are held on the use of the different types of fire extinguishers and evacuation procedures.

The Kings Mountain Fire Department works closely with the hospital. They conduct routine inspections, like the one done recently, to familiarize themselves with exits and evacuation procedures in the event of fire. They learn the location of electric panels, oxygen and gas cutoffs, and hook-ups for fire hoses in order to take care of a fire as quickly as possible.
