## Outpatient precautions to take

Anesthesia is not minor. While outpatient surgery seems minor because you don't stay in the hospital overnight, be sure to take certain precautions.

After outpatient surgery, have someone drive you home and watch for signs of problems, such as nausea. Be sure not to operate any vehicle for at least 24-hours due to anesthesia after-effects. Do not drink alcohol or take medications the first full day, as these may interact with the anesthetic still in your body.

Outpatients recover at home. Make sure you follow doctor's orders, so you, too, will recover.
