Duke Has Services For Visually Impaired

Duke Power Co. today announced a special service for the visually impaired.

"Starting today, customers who are visually impaired will be able to receive billing information and valuable energy saving ideas printed in Braille," said Joe Souther, Branch Manager. "This service, called Energy Information in Braille, will be available at no cost to the customer."

Duke Power Co. is providing this service in conjunction with Metrolina Association for the Blind, a private, non-profit agency in Charlotte that serves the visually impaired. Metrolina will use their equipment to transcribe regular print into Braille. Computer technology will permit data stored in Duke Power's computers to travel by telephone wires to the computer located in

Metrolina's offices and then to its special printing equipment.

"Duke Power is one of the few utilities in the country that provides this type of service," said Mr. Souther. "Energy Information in Braille is one way that we can respond to customers with special needs."
