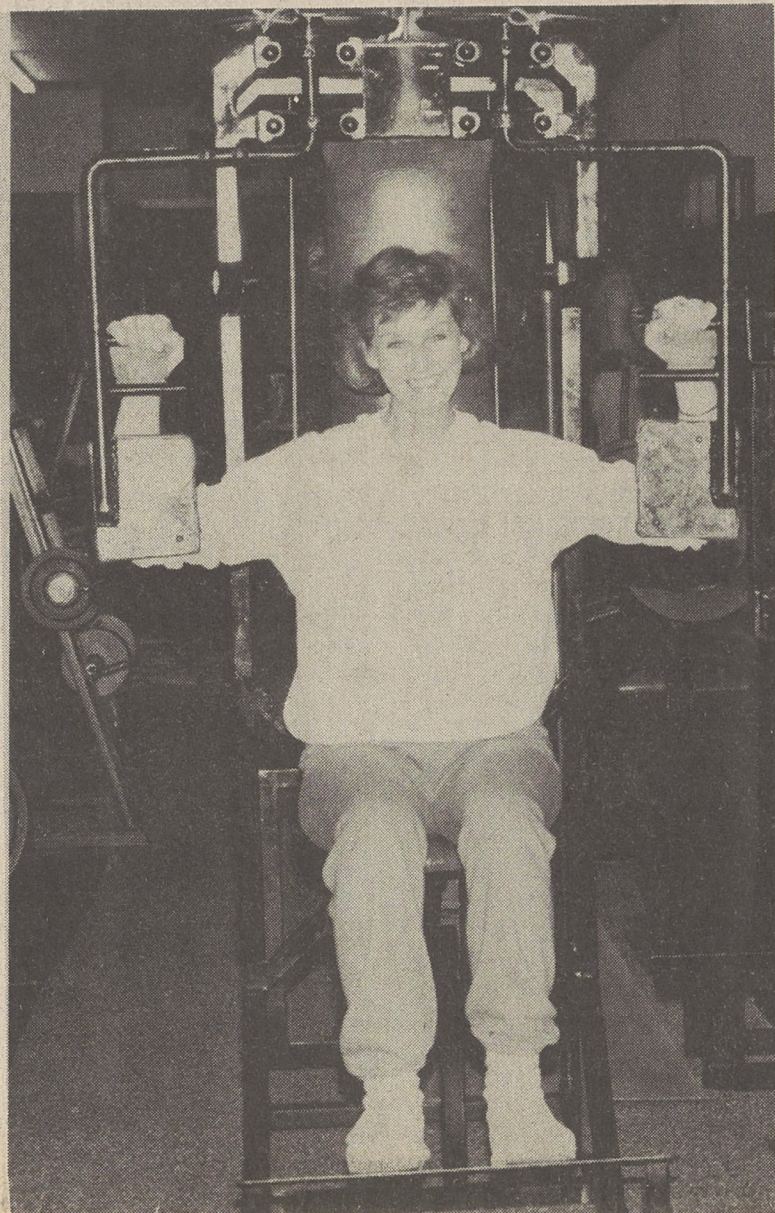
Anyone may obtain the stick-on numbers by going by Home Federal's office on West King Street.
