NUTTY FINGERS
 1/2 lb. butter or margarine
 4 Tbsp. powdered sugar
 2 cups chopped nuts
 1/2 tsp. salt
 1 Tbsp. vanilla
 2 cups plain flour
 Cream sugar and butter. Add all other ingredients and mix well. Pinch off small amount of dough and roll between hands to shape roll about size of little finger. Place on cookie sheet and bake at 375 degrees for 10 minutes or until very lightly browned. Remove from cookie sheet and roll in powdered sugar (small amount of powdered sugar on wax paper). May be stored in covered containers.

CHEESE BREAD
 2 cups Biscuit Mix
 3/4 cup water
 2 eggs
 2 tsp. dry mustard
 1 1/2 cups grated sharp cheese
 2 Tbsp. butter
 a little chili powder (optional)
 Mix together, put in loaf pan. Sprinkle some cheese on top. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.

CHERRY BANANAS DELIGHT
 1 cup flour
 1 cup pecans, chopped
 1 stick butter, melted
 Make into paste. Spread with a fork into an 11x14 pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Let cool.
 1 cup powdered sugar
 8 oz. cream cheese
 1 carton Cool Whip, large
 Mix and cream together. Spread over first layer.
 1 can cherry pie filling-spread over 2nd layer
 6 slices bananas, over pie filling
 1 pkg. instant vanilla pudding
 2 cups milk
 Mix pudding mix with milk. Spread over bananas, etc. Save enough Cool Whip to

 1 lb. ground beef
 2 1/2 Tbsp. shortening or 1/4 cup corn oil
 1/4 cup chopped onion
 1/8 tsp. pepper
 1/2 tsp. salt
 1/4 cup catsup
 1 cup tomato sauce
 9 slices cheese (or cover top of 9x9 pan)
 1 can biscuits
 Brown beef and onions in shortening. Drain, add salt and pepper. Stir. Then add catsup and tomato sauce stir-

ring until mixed well. Pour into pan, cover with cheese, then top with biscuits. Bake for about 15 minutes at 425 degrees. Serves 6.
AMERICAN CHOW MEIN
 1 lb. ground beef
 1 cup chopped onions
 1 cup chopped green peppers

1 cup chopped celery
 1 cup uncooked rice
 2 1/2 cups canned tomatoes
 Brown ground beef, drain. Layer remaining ingredients in order listed. Put lid on. Cook on medium heat for 1 hour, or until rice is tender. Serves 8.

COCONUT PIE
 1 1/2 cups sugar
 1 stick margarine, melted
 3 eggs
 1 Tbsp. vinegar
 1 tsp. vanilla flavoring
 1 can coconut
 Mix all ingredients, pour into unbaked shell. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.
