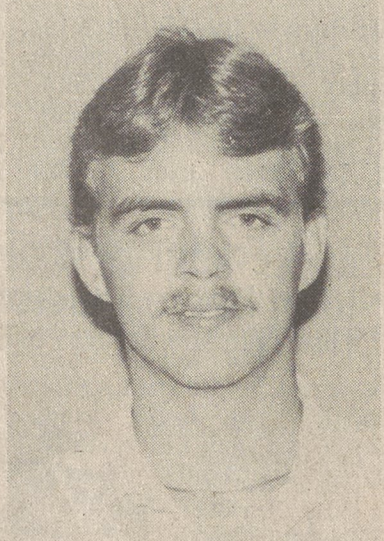


**Robbie Ervin Joins Staff

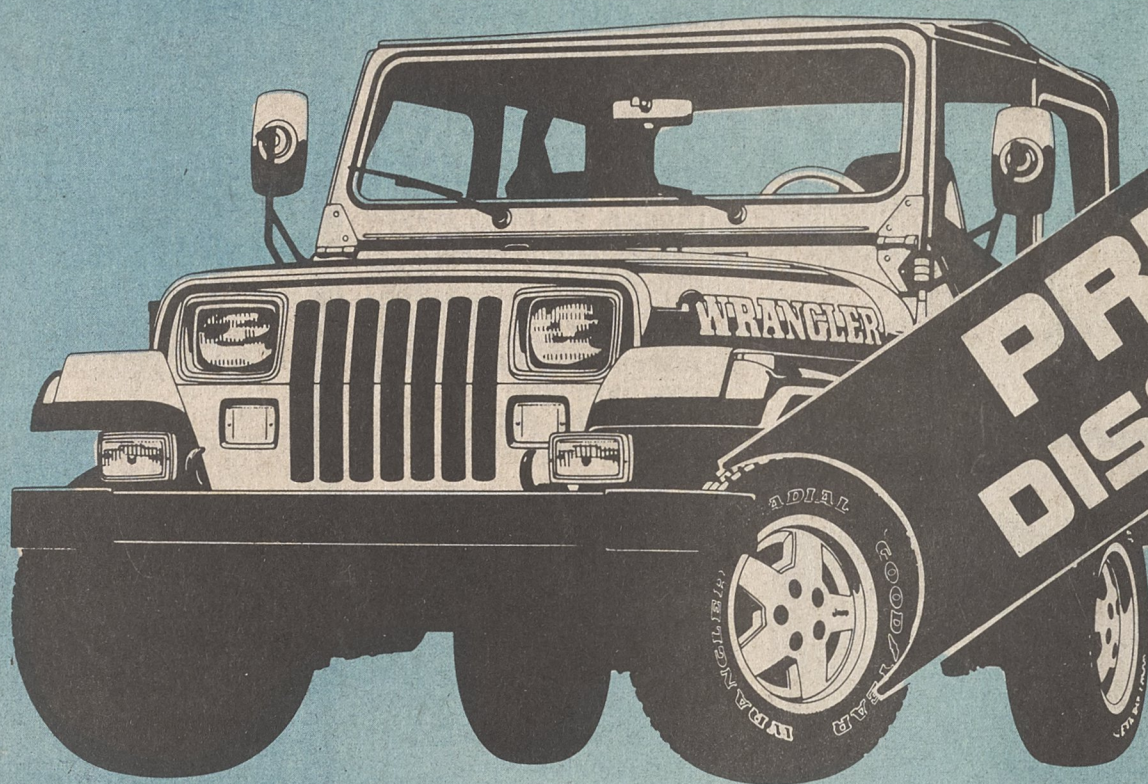
