said there are at least that many more out at various

places in the city. She said the names were obtained through door-to-door solicitation by many people in the

community "who strongly oppose the use of taxpayers money for luxuries."

"This money is not a one time pay, but for our lifetime. Anything such as necessities to keep the city going we do not feel we need to speak out. But as of recreational projects or luxuries, we feel we need to have our say", said Mrs. Herndon. "Let the people who made our city what it is have their vote on this. They've earned it or at least the names on this petition think so. Other programs such as meals on wheels and cutbacks in our city schools and poor pay for our city workers trouble us more than a swimming pool. These people depending on meals on wheels and our school system should come first. These are the people who have made our city. There's a swimming pool in our budget now. Why not cover the pool (Deal Street), heat it, and let this pool serve the purpose for now. Or is it because you know no one uses it or would ever use it? Let the people who have made our city what it is have their vote on this. They've earned it or at least these names on this petition think so. We ask or request that you rescind the action taken at your last meeting in reference to budgeting \$15,000 per year to the pool committee and call for a public referendum."

Mrs. Herndon's remarks drew loud applause from a large number of people in the audience.

The Mayor accepted the petition, without comment from commissioners, and said he would present copies to all six members of the board of commissioners. No action was taken.

### KM Citizens Are Reminded Of Ordinances

This is the season for outdoor gardening and yard work and the city sanitation department reminds home owners of special ordinances pertaining to tree limbs, cuttings, shrubbery, leaves and etc.

Tree limbs, cuttings, shrubbery, etc. of more than one (1) load will be hauled at such time as trucks are available; provided, that such limbs, cuttings, shrubbery, etc., are cut in lengths that can be handled by two (2) men, and placed on the front corner of the owner's or tenant's property nearest the street right-of-way. Lawn trimmings shall be placed in boxes or cans for pickup.

Loose leaves may be placed along the curb for pickup and collection by the Sanitation Department of the City of Kings Mountain from November 1st through December 31st. Leaves must be bagged and placed on the front corner of the owner's or tenant's property nearest the street right-of-way beginning January 1st through October 31st.

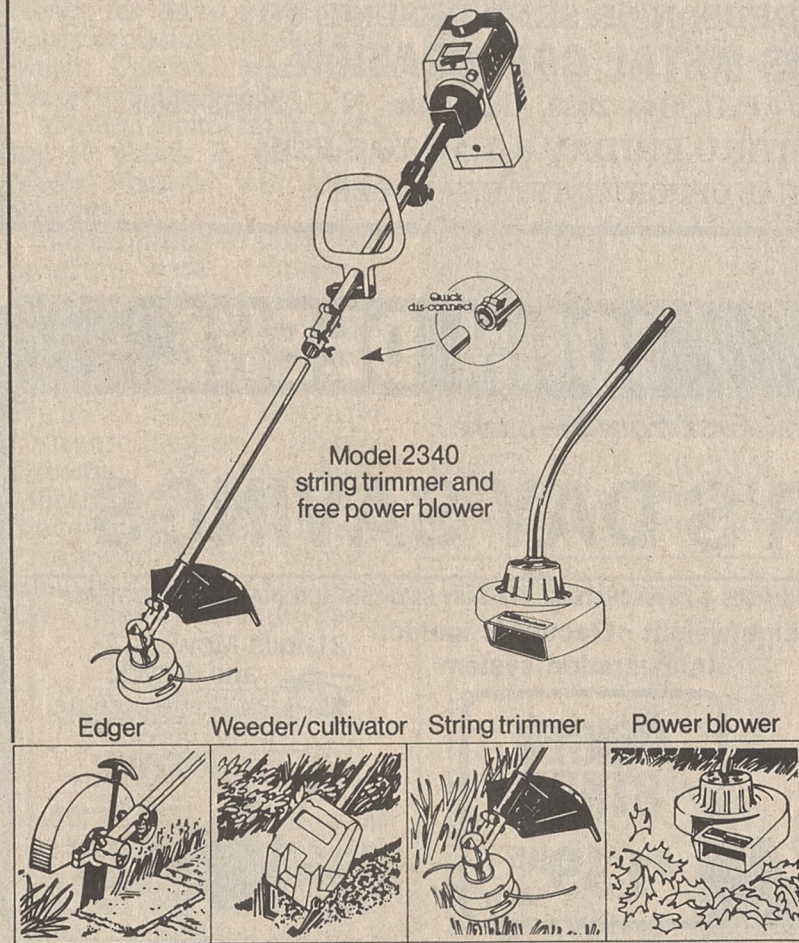

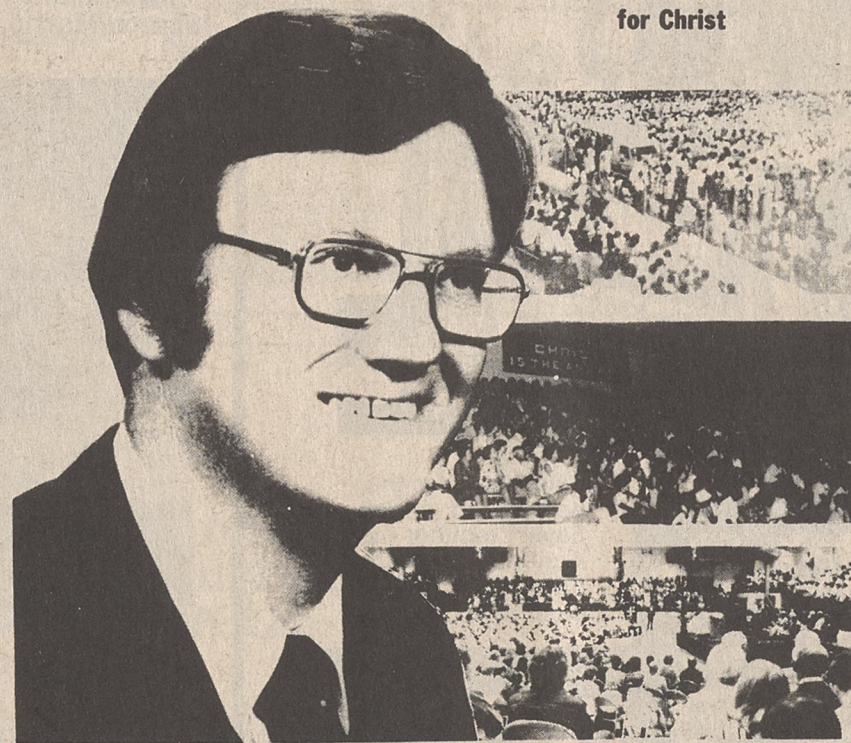
