The City of Kings Mountain, in regular session at 7:30 P.M. on June 10, 1986 adopted the following amendments to Section 12 Chapter 11 of the Kings Mountain Zoning Ordinance.

Sec. 12-11. Wrecked junked automobiles.

It shall be unlawful for any person to place, keep, store or otherwise allow any junked or wrecked automobile or other vehicle which may constitute a sanitary or attractive nuisance or otherwise be a menace to the health and welfare of the citizens of the city within or upon any portion of real property owned by him or otherwise, except within a duly licensed junk yard.

(a) It is hereby noted that for the purpose of this ordinance a wrecked, junked automobile, or other vehicle is defined as one that is in a state of disrepair and incapable of being moved under its own power.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Kings Mountain, in regular session at 7:30 P.M. on June 10, 1986 adopted the following amendment to Section 24 Chapter 118 of the Kings Mountain Zoning Ordinance.

Sec. 24-118. Same—Abandoned vehicles.

The city shall have the authority to declare vehicles which are left unaccompanied on any street, highway or private property for a period of not less than seven (7) days abandoned. If the board of commissioners shall then declare said vehicle to be a health or safety hazard, the city may designate an official to give written notice to the owner, lessee or occupant thereof and fifteen (15) days from said notice shall have the right to go upon said property and remove said vehicle without the written request of the owner, lessee or occupant. Upon removal of the vehicle, after obtaining possession thereof, it shall be the duty of the owner of such vehicle to pay to the city all reasonable costs incident to the removal, storage and locating the owner of the vehicle. The city shall have the authority to dispose of said vehicle pursuant to state law. (Ord. of 4-21-66, § 1). State law reference—Similar state law, G.S. § 160-200(43).

(a) It is hereby noted that for the purpose of this paragraph, an abandoned motor vehicle is defined as one that is in a state of disrepair and incapable of being moved under its own power.
