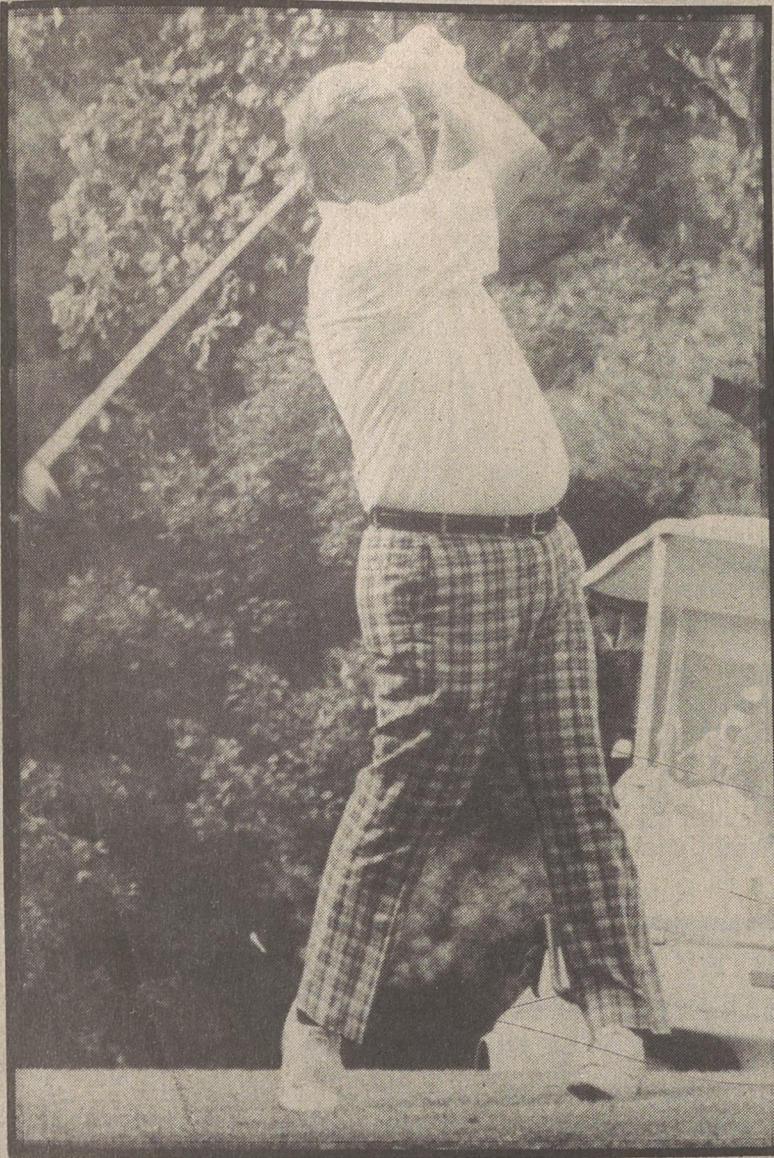


# Jackson, Abercrombie Win KMCC Tournament

Stoney Jackson and Terry Abercrombie fired a tournament record 62-64-126 Saturday and Sunday to win the Kings Mountain Country Club Men's Member-Guest Golf Tournament.

Jackson and Abercrombie won by six shots over Mickey Powers and Don Teague, who fired a 67-65-132. Danny Shockley and Jim Jones, who were only two behind going into the final 18 holes, finished at 64-70-134 for third place.

Scott Cloninger and Junior Wilson won the championship B flight with a 139 score. Terry Leonard's team was second with a 142, winning a playoff over Jerry Ross and Carl Bell.

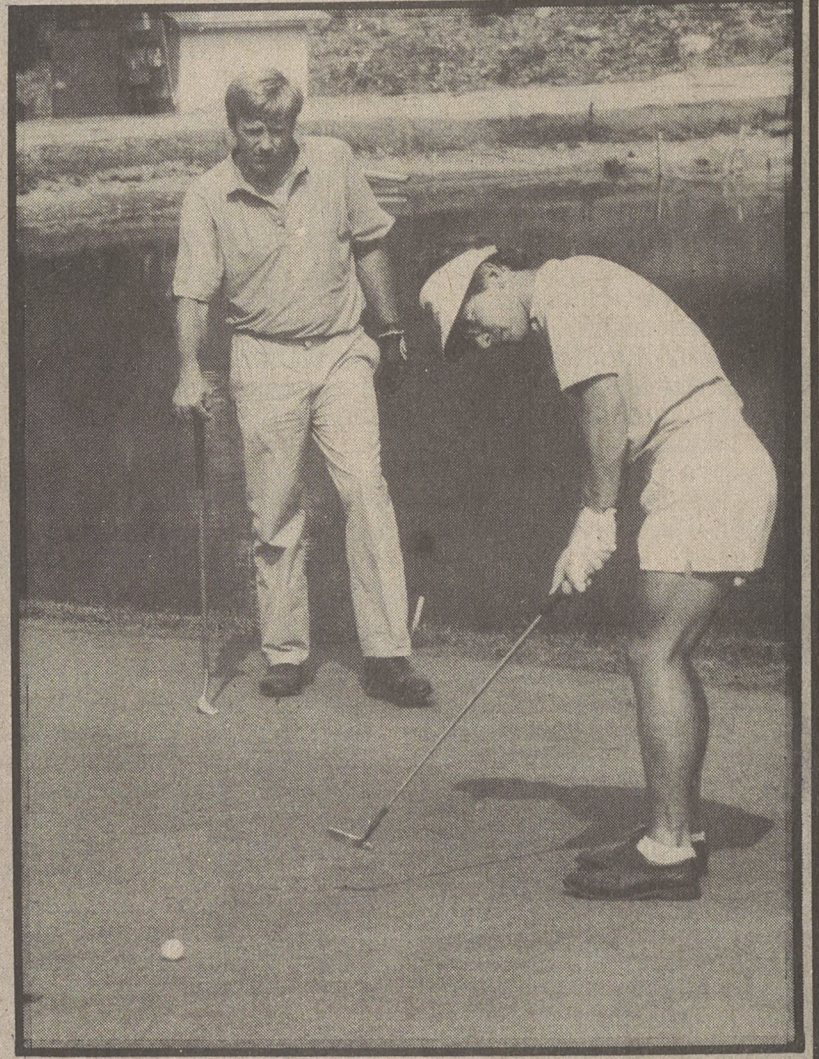
Buck McGinnis and his partner took first flight honors with a 140, seven strokes ahead of David Brinkley and his partner and Gene Timms and Kyle Milner.

Ron Queen and Frank Helton were the second flight winners, shooting a 146 to edge Mike Ballard and Guy Trout by a single stroke. Casey Durham and Artie Kilgore were third at 150.

Rick Moore and his partner won the third flight with a 151. Chuck Austin and his partner won second place with a 156, winning a playoff over Paul Hendricks and Bucky Cozart.

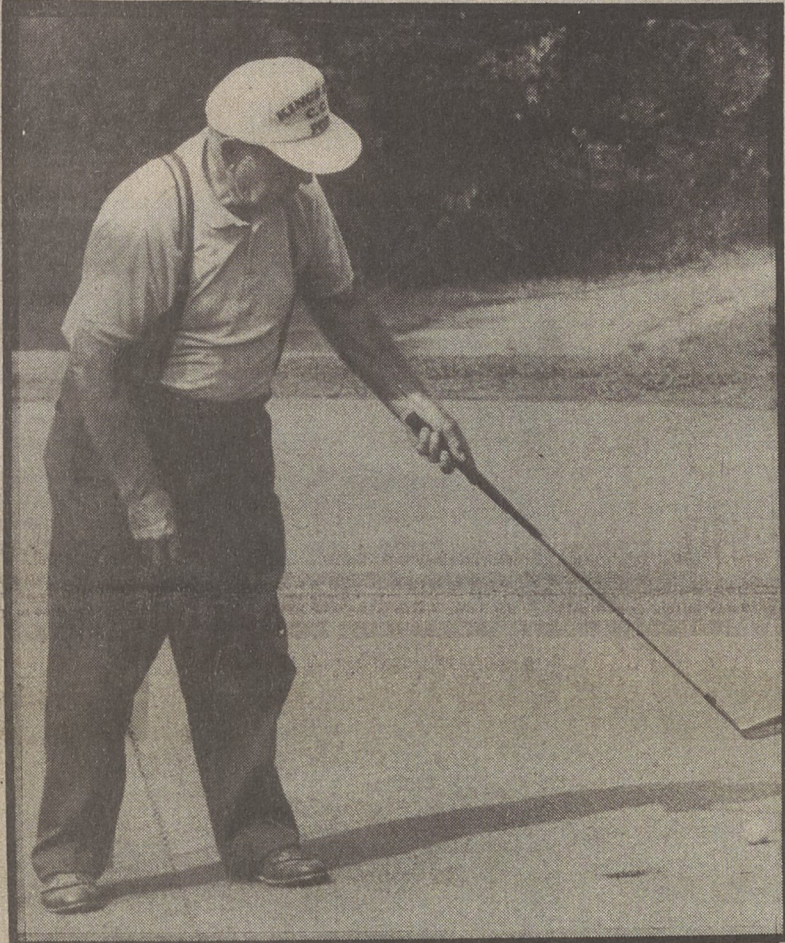

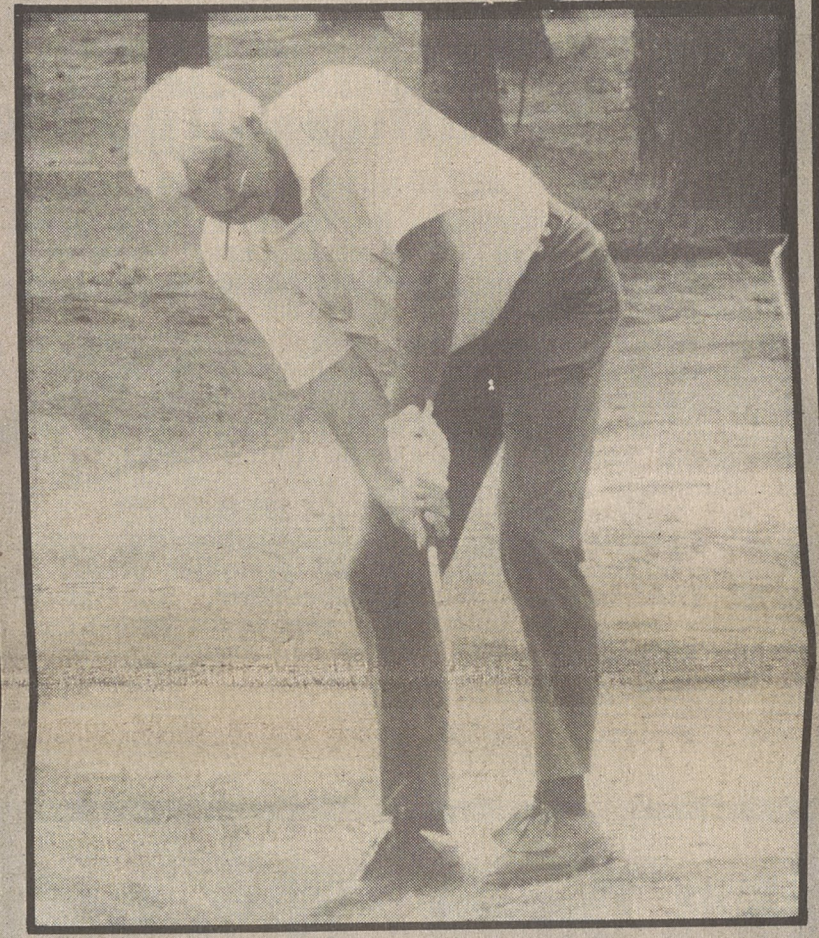

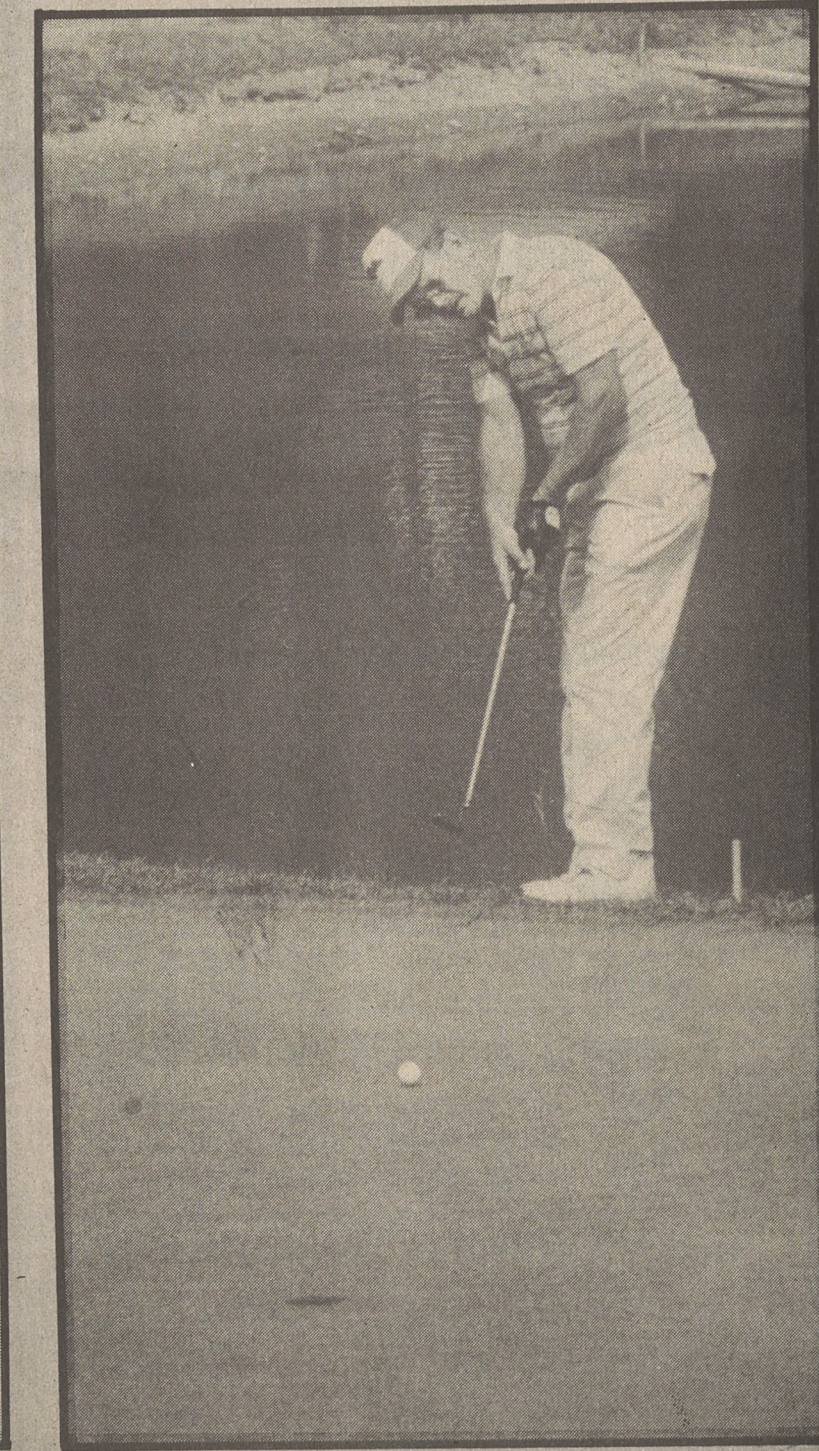
**CHIP SHOT**-Gene Stone chips onto the 6th green in Sunday's Member-Guest Golf Tournament at Kings Mountain Country Club.
