crafts chairman. Circle 3's recipe for mission bean soup: Wash beans thoroughly. Place in large kettle, cover with water. Add 2 teaspoons salt and soak overnight. Drain. Add 2 quarts water and ham or ham hock. Cover and bring to a boil; reduce heat and simmer 21/2 to 3 hours and add: 1 large onion; one large can

tomatoes, coarsely chopped; one pod red pepper, optional, or 1 teaspoon chili powder; juice of one lemon; and salt and pepper to taste. Simmer another 30

minutes, stirring occasionally. Remove ham hock from soup. Remove meat from bone, chop meat and return to soup. Serve with crackers or cornbread and a salad: Yield, 2½ quarts.
