

The purpose of the Qualla organization is to provide made basketry, pottery, employment for the Cherokee stone carvings, beadwork, Indians and to preserve their ancient art and craft skills for future generations.

"This is the first time since our organization began in

the public a catalog," said Betty Dupree, Manager of the Qualla Arts and Craft Mutual. "This new catalog showcases the very culture of the Cherokee Indian Nation through the work of our highly skilled Indian artists and craftpersons."

According to Dupree all


"The catalog is so interesting that it is almost a work of art in itself," said Dupree.
