## Indoor Track Added

CHAPEL HILL -- Indoor track has been added to the championship slate of the North Carolina High School Athletic Association for 1987.

Practice for indoor track will begin on December 1, with the first date of competition on December 13. The combined men's and women's championships will be held at the University of North Carolina's Joe Hilton Arena on February 7.

A series of qualifying meets will be held on the UNC-Chapel Hill campus, and schools may also hold outdoor meets using indoor events if weather permits.

Approximately 60 teams competed in indoor track last year, which prompted the addition of the championship. The NCHSAA now offers 20 championship playoffs, including 11 for men and nine for women.

In the third quarter, Wofford recovered a fumble at the Blue Devil 37 but three plays later, Von Ramsuer recovered a Cherryville fumble at the 32. With time running out in Chapter Three, the Cherryville defense stopped a fourth down play and took over at their 48 but failed to move it.

After taking possession at their 20, Maiden failed to move it but a pass interference penalty gave the visitors a first down. Wofford, a senior defensive end, broke through to smear quarterback Ikard for an 18-yard loss on third down and the Devils had to punt.

With 4:31 left in the game, Ikard fielded a Brian Short punt at his 30, shook off one tackler, and sped 70 yards down the sideline for six points. The middle of the Cherryville defense stopped Robby Holloway on a two-point conversion try.

Maiden was to have one last chance to pull it out but again the Ironmen stiffened on defense. Maiden moved into Cherryville territory in the final seconds but with only 0:11 to go, the CHS defense broke through to block Jamie Walker's field goal effort from the 30.

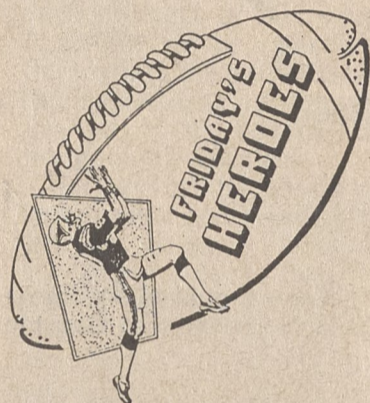
"It sure feels good to beat Tom Brown for the first time," said Frank Morehead after the game. Brown, nam-

ed prep coach of the year in 1949, had beaten Cherryville seven straight times. Both Morehead and Maiden's Brown said that Foster's run-down of Ikard in the second quarter was the game's biggest play.

Morehead, Cherryville's fifth year coach, was also impressed by the play of his of-

fensiveline in the first half. "Our tackles and guards opened up big holes for our backs in the first half and we should have scored two more but the tough Maiden defense had something to do about that," added the mentor.
