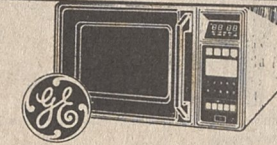
### Couple Entertains At P.E.O. Meeting

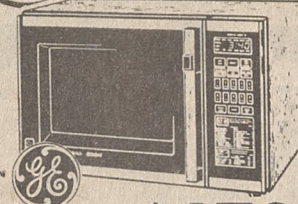
The Bridges home was beautifully decorated for the holidays.

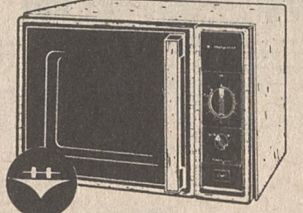

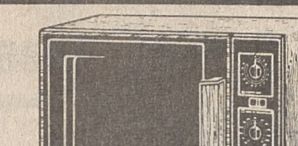

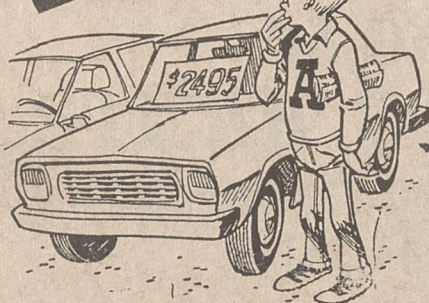
