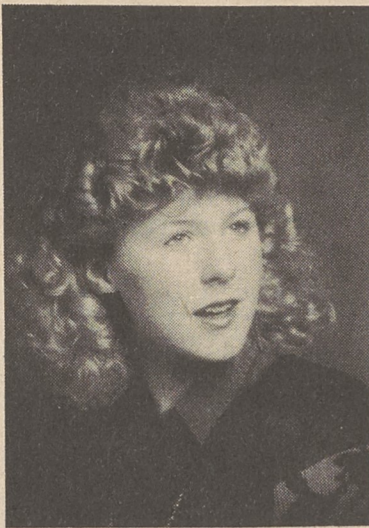


Fashion Preview Set At Cleveland Tech

Form W-4 Training Session Set

The Tax Reform Act of 1986 requires all employees to file a new form W-4, Employees Withholding Allowance Certificate.

The new form should be submitted immediately so the correct amount of tax will be withheld for the year. If an employee does not submit a new form W-4, the amount of tax may not be correct.
