Robert F. Henderson, Jr., has been named vice president of Human Resources at Gaston Memorial Hospital, Gastonia.

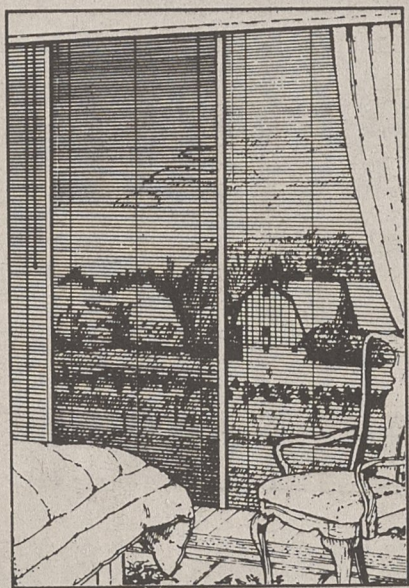
His most recent position was director of Personnel Services at Jackson-Madison County General Hospital, Jackson, TN, a major west Tennessee referral center.
