

Mountaineer Dixie Boys Win Pair

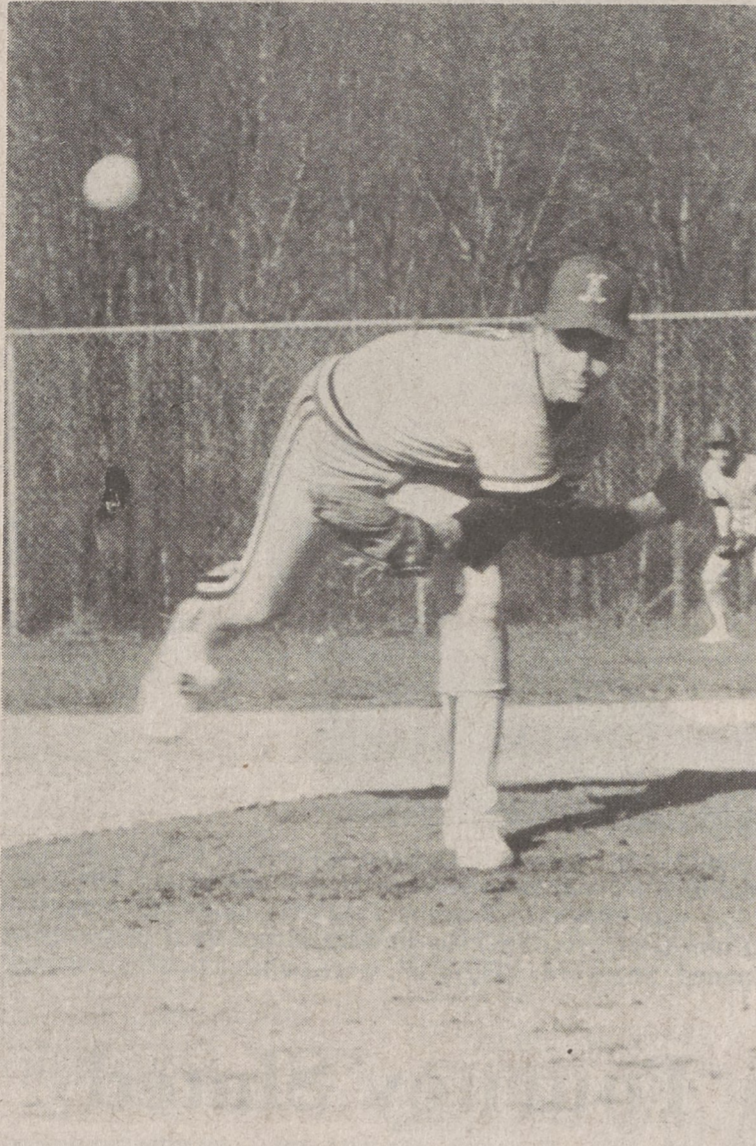
Mountaineer Restaurant's 13-14 year old Dixie Boys baseball team won three of four games during the past week.
