Here are some safety tips:
—Stop your mail and newspaper deliveries. Arrange to have your lawn moved

—Lock your garage door.

If you have valuables in the house, take them to your bank for storage in a safe

—Set your light timers. Set them logically. Living room lights should go on in the evening. Bedroom lights should go on later. A bathroom light can go on anytime A burgler observing anytime. A burglar observing your neighborhood will be looking for a pattern that tells him which houses are vacant.

-Move all ladders, tools, lawn implements, garbage cans and yard furniture to your garage, basement or storage shed.

-Unplug all electrical appliances such as radios, television sets, irons, washers, and fans to prevent possible damage from electrical storms.

-Turn down the volume control on your telephone so that the ringing cannot be heard from outside.

-Close all windows and sliding doors and lock them. Make sure that the "Charley bar" is secure on sliding doors, and that all screens or storm windows are locked or fastened securely.

-Put window shades in normal daytime position, and make sure all main floor drapes, shades and curtains are arranged so the neighbors and police can see

into your house.

—If you are leaving a car or other vehicle in your driveway, make sure it is locked.


