Several returning starters from last year's team, which finished third in the SWC, make this year's club strong. Heading the list is senior Ashley McGinnis who was undefeated and making a strong bid for conference player of the year honors when she suffered a knee injury in a match against Shelby and had to miss that match and the season's finale against North Gaston. KM went on to lose both matches.

J.J. Warlick, who qualified for the state tournament last year, also returns and she and McGinnis should form one of the top 1-2 punches anywhere.

"With Ashley and J.J. returning with experience, we'll be in contention," said Holtzclaw. "J.J. is undefeated in two years of varsity tennis and she and Ashley destroyed their doubles opponents as well."

Other returnees include Paula Morris, Lee Ann Masters, Ashley Champion, Betsy McIntyre and Kim Ware, who are battling freshmen Christy Dixon and

Susan Hendricks for the third through sixth singles positions.

Bridges and Karen Bush, who'll be valuable to our success," said Holtzclaw. "I am very pleased with the way this group of girls has progressed thus far and we look forward to a successful season."
