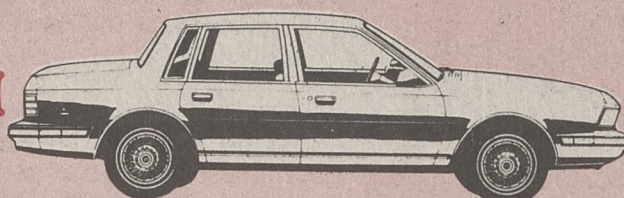
The mill is owned by Mr. and Mrs. Kelly Bunch.

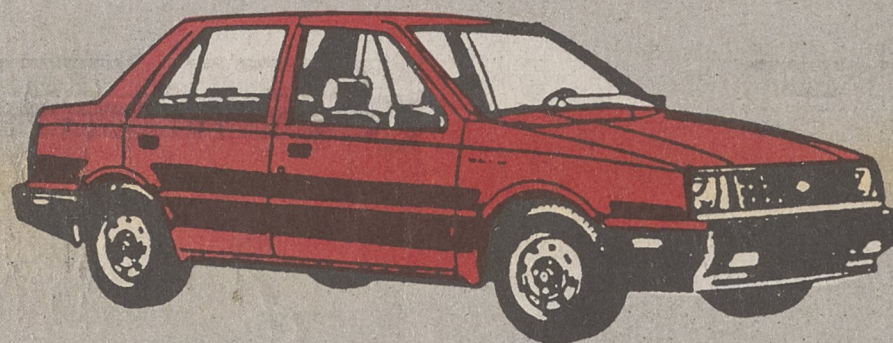
