## Dog Warden Cracking Down On Animals Running Loose

## King Celebration Slated Saturday

A birthday celebration to salute and give special recognition to the late Dr. Martin Luther King will be held at Kings Mountain Community Center Saturday at 5:30 p.m.

The public is invited to the semi-formal dinner and to hear Professor Forest Toms, psychologist and professor at Middle Tennessee State University, Murfreesboro, Tenn., guest speaker. Toms is a native of Shelby and will speak on the theme, "A Dream, Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow." Top entertainment is also slated and young people, as well as adults, are encouraged to attend.

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., who was born Jan. 15, 1929, became the international symbol of the American civil rights movement. Along with his intensely emotional spiritual growth, Dr. King's life transformed from a 26 year old minister of a modest black Baptist Church in Montgomery, Alabama into one of the most outstanding spokesmen of the black

freedom struggle. He dedicated his life to the struggle against discrimination, poverty and violence, giving his life to and for the movement.

Joseph L. Rauch, a general counselman of the leadership conference on civil rights and long time civil liberties attorney, acclaimed King as the "man who sparked the civil rights movement by teaching blacks to hope and whites to care."

King received the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964. He led the Montgomery bus boycott in 1955, the Birmingham and the march on Washington in 1963; Selma and the Voting Right Act 1965; and the poor people's campaign in Memphis 1967, where he lost his life.
