

## Meeks KM's Only Track Winner

Kings Mountain's Cliff Meeks was a double-winner in the Southwestern 3-A Conference track meet Thursday at Shelby High School.

The senior standout won the 1,600 meter run in 4:45.83 minutes and the 3,200 meter run in 10:37.04.

Shelby won the team title with 159 points, followed by East Rutherford 99½, R-S Central 76, South Point 61½, North Gaston 49, Kings Mountain 47, Chase 44 and Burns 14.

Meeks was the only first place winner for the Mountaineers. Other Mountaineers placing were:

Ron Ruffin, sixth in the long jump, 20'2".

Wayne Brazzell, second in the shot put, 43'6".

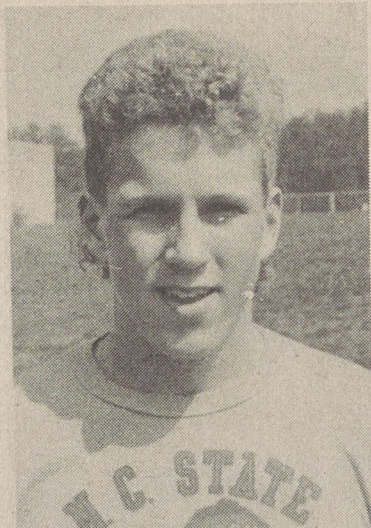
Daniel Long, second in the pole vault, 11 feet even.
