Following a wedding trip to Florida, the couple will reside at 112 Robinson Drive, Kings Mountain.

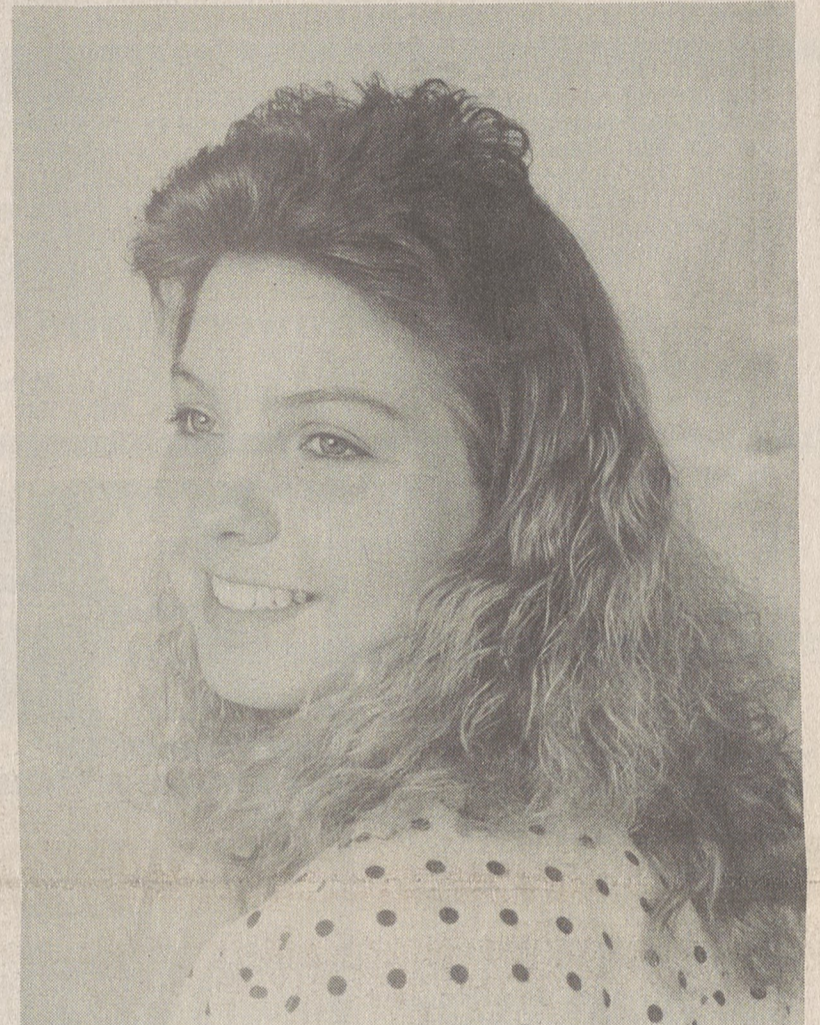

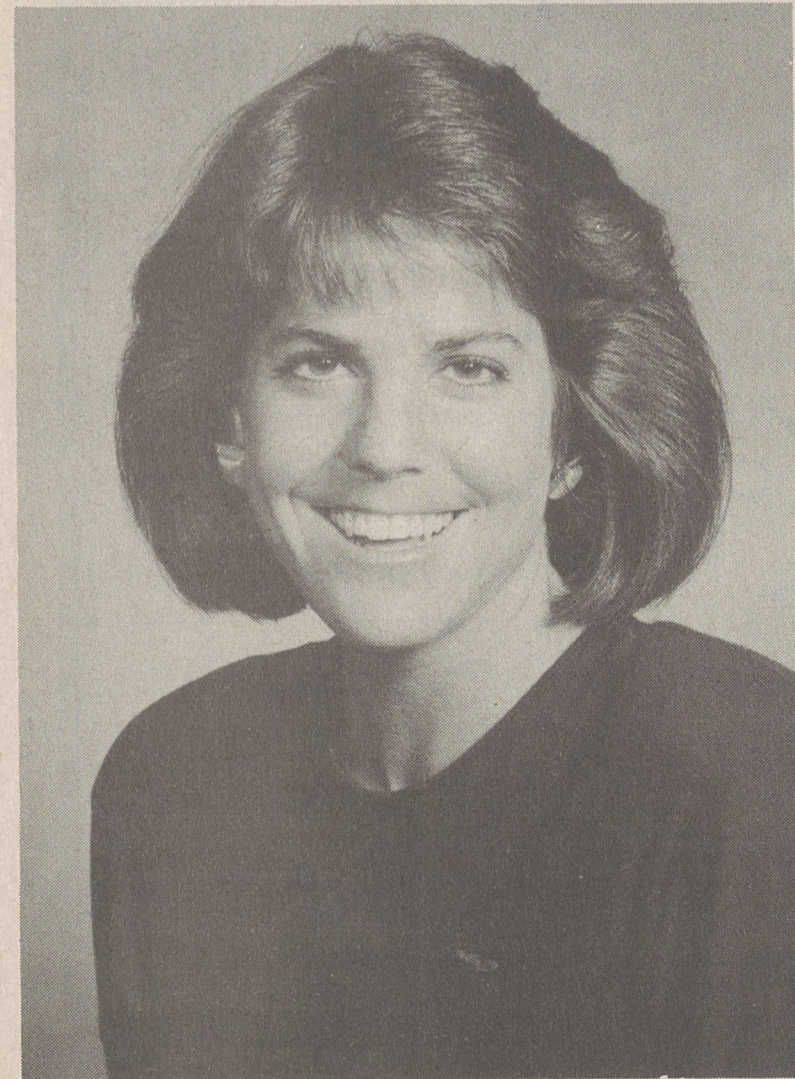
Stephanie Honored

Mrs. Grances Collins of Gastonia, and her daughter, Miss Sandra Collins of Rowan County, assisted with hostess duties.

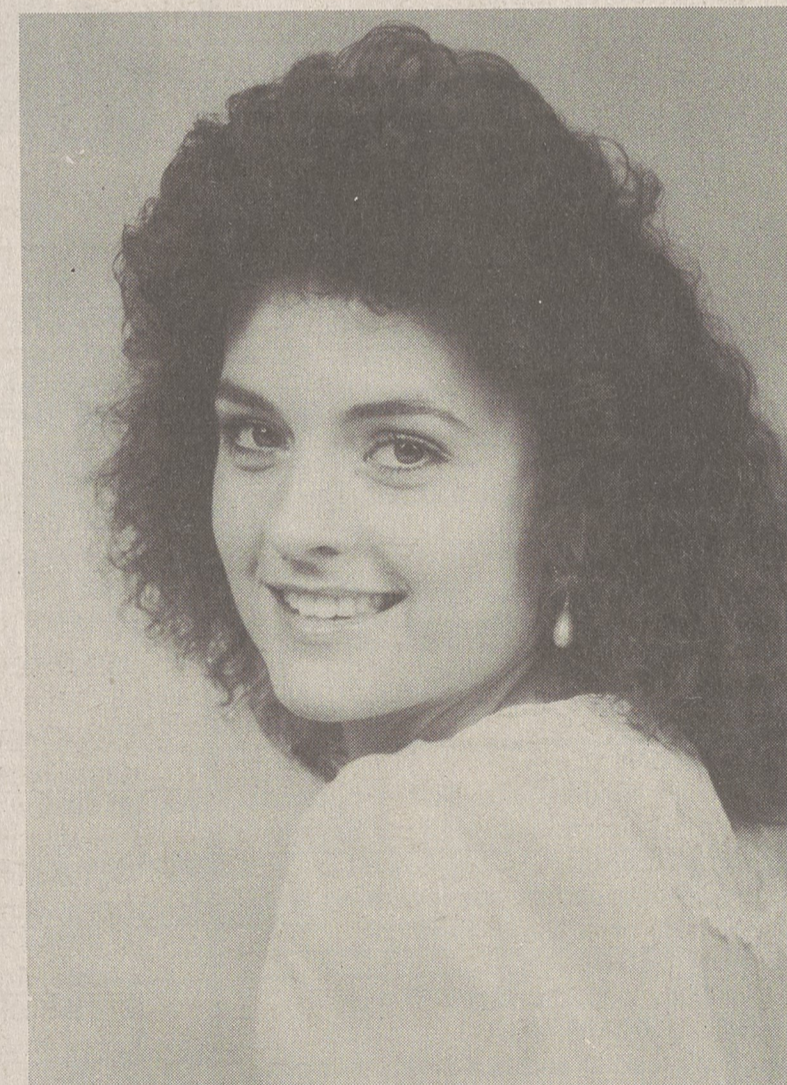
Guests were served punch and spicy hot cheese balls upon arrival. Later guest were invited to the lovely decorated dining area
