

Hospital Opens New Facility

SHELBY — Cleveland Memorial Hospital is now accepting patients in its new 29-bed skilled nursing facility.

The new unit, located on the fourth floor of the hospital, primarily will serve hospital patients ready to be discharged but needing nursing care in order to complete their recovery. Such patients are likely to be able to

handle daily living activities without much assistance, but require the care of licensed practical nurses or registered nurses for services such as IV therapy or tube feedings.

In the past, CMH patients ready to be discharged to area nursing homes offering skilled nursing care were sometimes turned away because the nursing homes were full. Patients then

had to be transferred to out-of-county nursing homes or remain in the hospital.

Cleveland Memorial's new skilled nursing facility solves the problem by providing an interim home to these patients until a bed becomes available at a private facility.

"Our objective is to assist patients in being able to function as best they can with their conditions and to help them improve with the support of family and health care professionals," says the facility's Clinical Manager Debra Greene, RN.

A big plus, says Greene, is that the facility will help keep patients close to their families. "Family members," she says, "play a vital role in the patient's recovery."

In addition to nurses, the facility is staffed by a social worker and an activity director. Hospital volunteers also will spend time daily visiting with the patients. The facility will have open visitation and family members will be encouraged to visit as much as they can.

Facilities include 13 private rooms and 8 semi-private rooms, a kitchenette for round-the-clock snacks, and a cheerful dining room and dayroom. Depending on the patient's needs and interests, a variety of activities are planned, including crafts, games and musical entertainment.

Volunteer Orientation Set

Orientation for people interested in working in the Kings Mountain Hospital Auxiliary will be held on Tuesday, June 21 at 9 AM in the hospital chapel.

After training volunteers will select the time, usually several hours a week, that they want to work in the hospital helping patients, families of the patients and the staff. There are opportunities to help the business office and the pharmacy, deliver the

mail and flowers, work with the new mother clinic, take magazines to patients and family and guide people around the hospital, to mention a few of the duties. Some volunteers enjoy seeing that tray favors are made, that special flowers beds are put in, and fixing layettes for newborns.

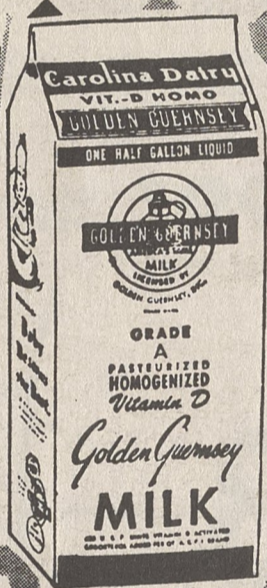

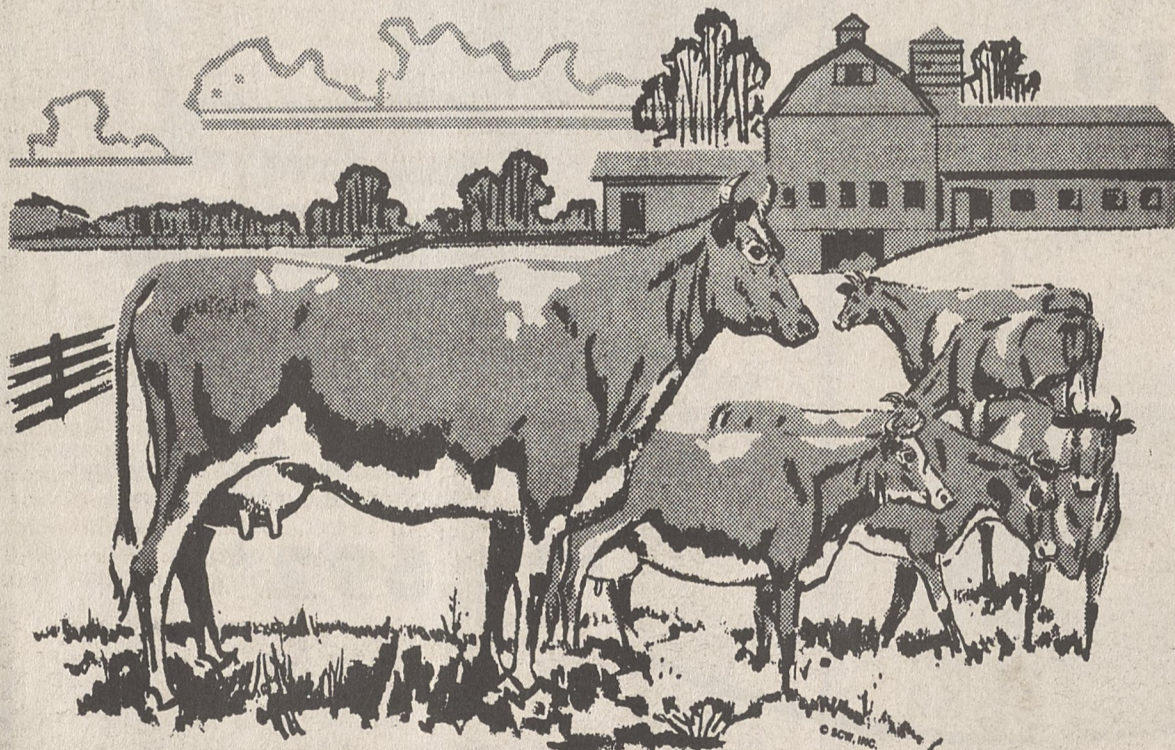
