## New Train Station Opens

elements. A freshly paved parking lot has space for 10 cars, as well as handicapped parking at this accessible facility.

At this time train service is limited to Amtrak's "Crescent" service. This run connects New York and New Orleans with daily service. Northbound service arrives in Gastonia at 12:24 a.m. (just after midnight) taking ticket holders to Washington, DC, Philadelphia and New York, among other stops. The Southbound "Crescent" stops in Gastonia at 2:48 a.m. for those willing to brave the late hour for comfortable and roomy travel to points South. Along the way to New Orleans, common destinations are Atlanta and Birmingham. The station is opened promptly at 11 pm and 2:00 am nightly by Amtrak custodian Lane Adams. Adams remains on duty until each train departs and assures the safety of his late night travelers and any hardy well wishers.

To inaugurate service on Wednesday, Amtrak's Washington Division District Supervisor, Ralph Mangum will be on hand to see that rail travelers make it to the new station. Mangum said that he is pleased Amtrak has this opportunity to better serve Gaston and Cleveland Counties with improved station facilities. His hope is that more people will choose rail travel and continue the resurgence of passenger service in this area.

The new station can be reached from I-85 at the East Gastonia-Hiway 7 Exit. Take Ozark Ave (7), one block west to Piedmont Ave. Turn left and follow to Airline Ave. The station is visible across the tracks on the left.

Those familiar with the road signs pointing them to the old sta-

tion should see the City of Gastonia road crew repositioning them toward the end of this week.

Since there is no ticket agent at Gastonia, ticketing can be ar-

ranged through Amtrak agents throughout the area at no additional charge. In Kings Mountain and Gastonia, Noel Travel Center can assist you with your rail plans, or dial 1-800-USA-RAIL.
