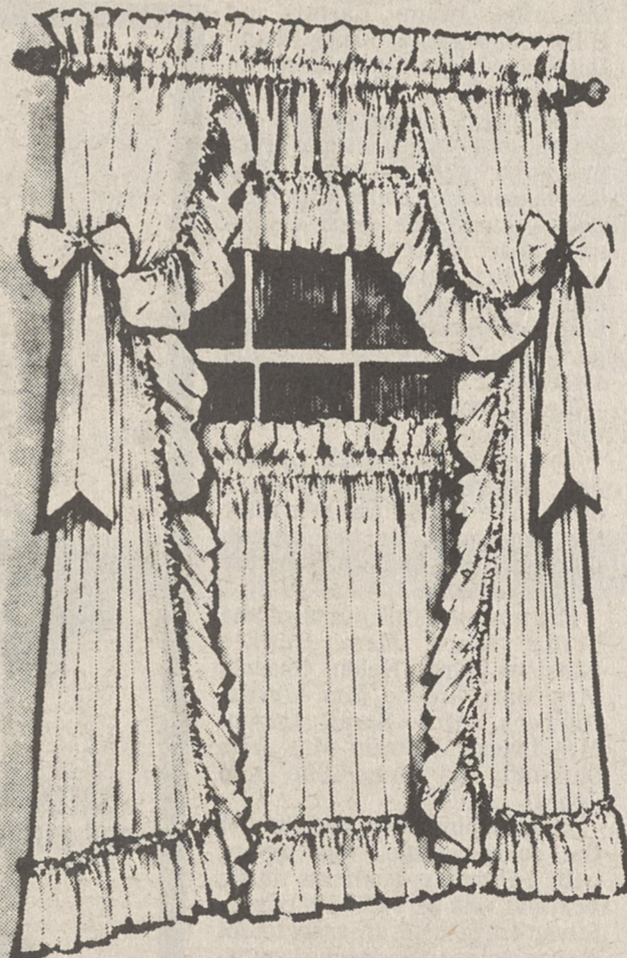
Following a wedding trip to the North Carolina mountains, the couple will make their home in Shelby.

This will be a workshop meeting featuring the Log Cabin block led by Ethel McGinnis, a quilting instructor from Kings Mountain.

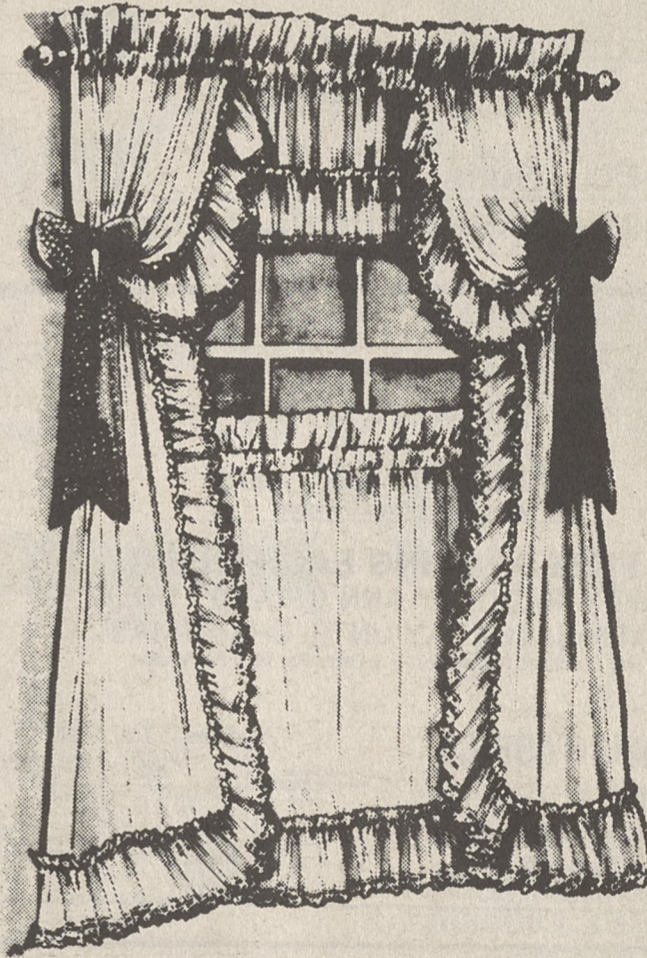
