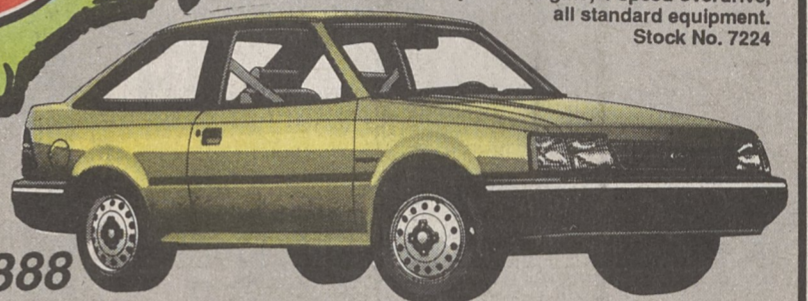

BOILING SPRINGS, N.C. - Gardner-Webb College President Dr. M. Christopher White has announced the appointment of Ralph W. Dixon Jr. of Shelby as vice president for college relations.
